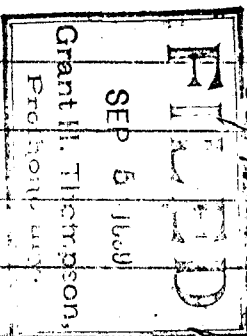

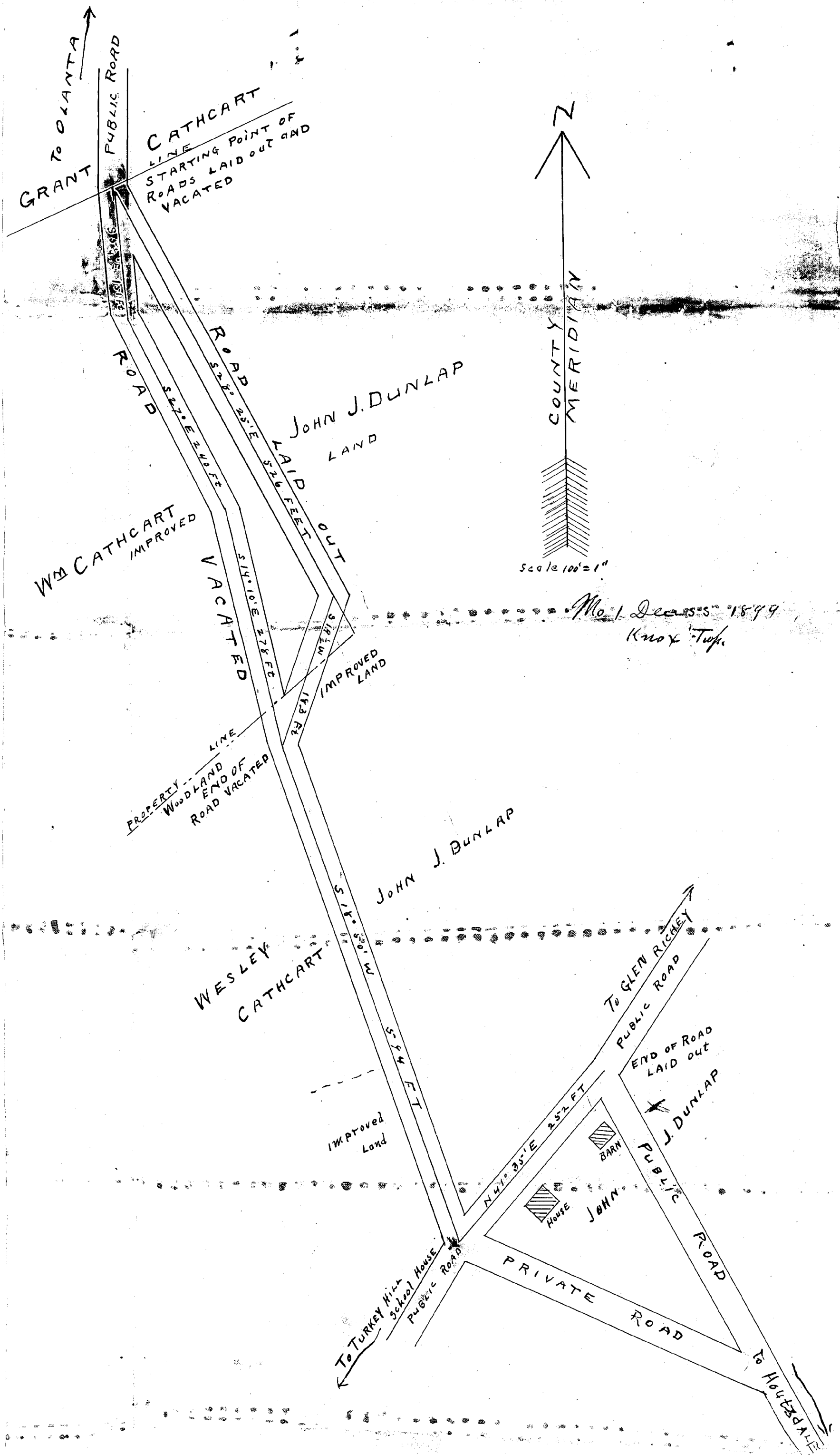

ty Pa. we, The undersigned, viewers appointed by The  
within order of court to view vacate and supply  
The road therein mentioned respectfully report that we  
gave good and lawful notice of said roadview with  
notice to The County Commissioners and The Supervisors  
of The said Township of Houtzdale which notices are hereto attached  
and made a part of this report. That we met at the time  
and place appointed in said notices, all being present  
and having been first severally sworn or affirmed  
we have viewed and do return for public use the  
following road to wit: beginning at a point on public road  
leading from Clauta to Houtzdale at line of Grant Cath-  
cart Thence following the Division line between land  
of Wm Cathcart and Geo J. Dunlap South twenty-eight  
degrees twenty five minutes East five hundred and twen-  
ty six feet to a post thence through land of William  
Cathcart aforesaid and land of John J. Dunlap aforesaid  
South sixteen and one half degrees West one hundred  
and eighty-three feet to a post in public road leading  
from Clauta to Houtzdale Thence by the centre line  
of the said road South Eighteen degrees and fifty minutes  
West five hundred and ninety four feet Thence  
North forty-one degrees thirty-five minutes East two hun-  
dred and fifty-two feet to post in road leading from Tur-  
key Hill Schoolhouse to Glen Richey at Barn of John J. Dunlap.  
which road so as aforesaid laid out is necessary in our opinion  
for a public road. We have surveyed of and vacated the road
