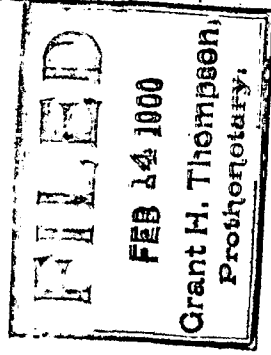

we, The undersigned, viewers appointed by the within  
order of court to view and lay out the road therein  
mentioned respectfully report, that we gave good  
and lawful notice of the said view with notice to  
the County Commissioners and Supervisors of the Twp of Union  
which notices are attached hereto and made a part of this  
report. That we met in accordance with the said  
notices and having been severally sworn or affirmed  
we viewed the ground for the proposed road and have  
laid out and do return for public use the following road  
to wit. Beginning at a point about two Rods West of the  
residence of David Syfers in road leading from Frank Colby's  
to Chandler dam Thence by the said road to post corner of  
Henry Shaffer and Frank Colby. Thence by their line  
North eighty eight degrees four minutes East eighty one and  
seven tenths Perches to a post Thence by line between  
the said Henry Shaffer and King South forty one min  
utes East ninety eight Perches to post corner  
of said Shaffer, King, Dan Huey and Joseph Walker  
Heirs, which road is necessary in our opinion  
for a public road. A plat & draft of the said road as  
laid out is herunto annexed showing courses dist-

Reviewers cannot interfere with damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.  
N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February, A. D. 1890, before Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Union

....., in said county, setting forth that  
They labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway beginning at a point on the public road leading from Frank Colby's to the Winterburn road at Chaudlers Dam about ten rods west of the residence of David Sydors in said Township and ending at a point near the residence of James Neimen.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law, and report to next term of Court whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Harry Byers, W. J. McCorkle and Thomas Smith who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.
