the next term of the Court

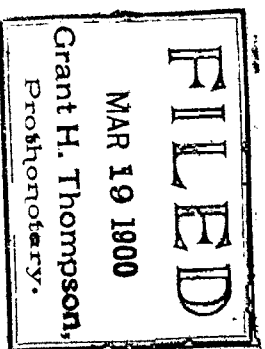
