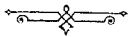

The undersigned Citizens of Lawrence Twp. Cleopatra Co. Pa. Respectfully Represent that a public Road was laid out to N<sup>o</sup> 7 September 1899 from a point on public road near the house of Joseph Porter, leaving from Othaula to Olanta, to a point in public road leaving from Morgan to J. S. Reed, near the house of Am Anderson. That said road has been opened in part; That your petitioners now pray your Honorable Court to appoint viewers to view and locate so much of said road as follows viz. 1<sup>st</sup> that part not opened where the same crosses the property of Joseph Porter and supply the same by a road beginning at a point about 25 or 30 feet from the point where the said road enters the public Road leading to Othaula from Olanta, and thence by new route to strike said public Road near the western line of Joseph Porter. 2<sup>d</sup> to locate so much of said road laid out beginning at a point in said road south of the line of Edward Swartsworth; thence by the nearest and best route to a point in the road leading from Reed to Morgan above near where the land line between Edwin Swartsworth and Anderson touches said Reed and Morgan Road, and to make report to your Honorable Court at the next term. At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of March, A. D. 1901, before the Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Lawrence

\_\_\_\_\_ , in said county, setting forth that a public road was laid out to No. 7 Sept. 28 1899 from a point on public road near the house of Joseph Foster leading from Oshanta to Clanta to a point in public road leading from Morgans to Jos. A. Reeds near the house of A. M. Andersons. That said road has been open in part. That your petitioners now pray your Honorable Court to appoint viewers to review<sup>ed</sup> and vacate so much of said road as follows, viz. 1<sup>st</sup> that part not opened where the same crosses the property of Joseph Foster<sup>ed</sup> supply the same by a road beginning at a point about 25.2 perches from the point where the said road enters the public road leading from Oshanta to Clanta. Thence by new route to strike said public road near the Western line of Joseph Foster. 2<sup>nd</sup> to vacate so much of said road laid out, beginning at a point in said road south of the line of Edward Swateworth. Thence by nearest<sup>ed</sup> best route to a point in the road leading from Reeds to Morgans at or near where the land line between Swateworth<sup>ed</sup> and Anderson to the said Reeds and Morgans Road. and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view<sup>ed</sup> and vacate<sup>ed</sup> and supply the same according to law, and Report to next term whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Harry Byers, Alex. Antes, and Edward Hoover who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to vacate<sup>ed</sup> and supply agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

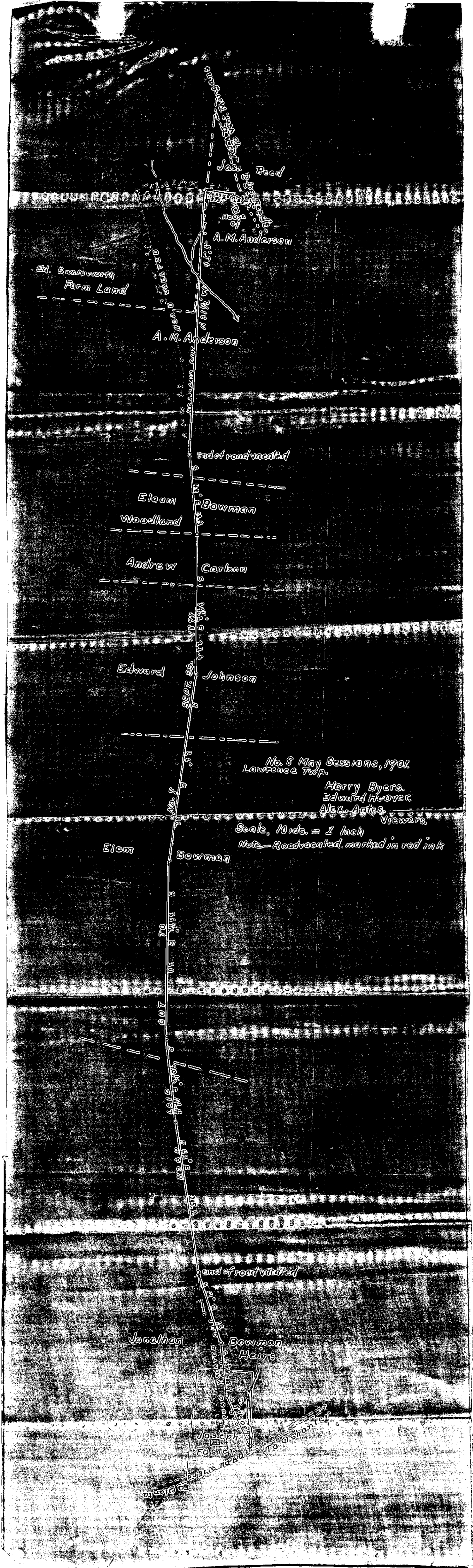

mentioned, respectfully report that we gave good and lawful  
notice of the said roadview with notice to County Commissioners and  
supervisors of Lawrence Township and was agreeable to the said  
notices and having been severally sworn or affirmed we  
viewed the road proposed for vacation and supply, and have vacated  
and supplied the same as follows; ~~that on~~ the road to no 7 Sept 55 1899, at  
that part of said road not opened, through land of Jonathan Bowman Estate  
and Joseph Foster beginning Thirty Three rods from where said road enters  
road from Ashanter to Clauta thence South forty three degrees East seven and  
eight tenth perches thence South forty four degrees East twenty  
five and two tenth perches crossing property of Jonathan Bowman Estate  
and Joseph Foster to road leading from Ashanter to Clauta at point  
near house of Joseph Foster which part above described of no 7 Sept 55
