At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 19 day of May, A. D. 1902, before the Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bloom

in said county, setting forth that

whereas the Citizens of Bloom Township suffer great inconvenience on account of having no public road in the Eastern End of said Township; therefore we the undersigned Citizens of the Township of Bloom respectfully petition the Honorable Court to appoint Viewers to locate a public road in said Township beginning at a public road of Powell Hagg's & intersect public road at S R Leonard's and thus we will ever pray

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view the same according to law,

whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Harry Byers James Savage & W J Huffer who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed

agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

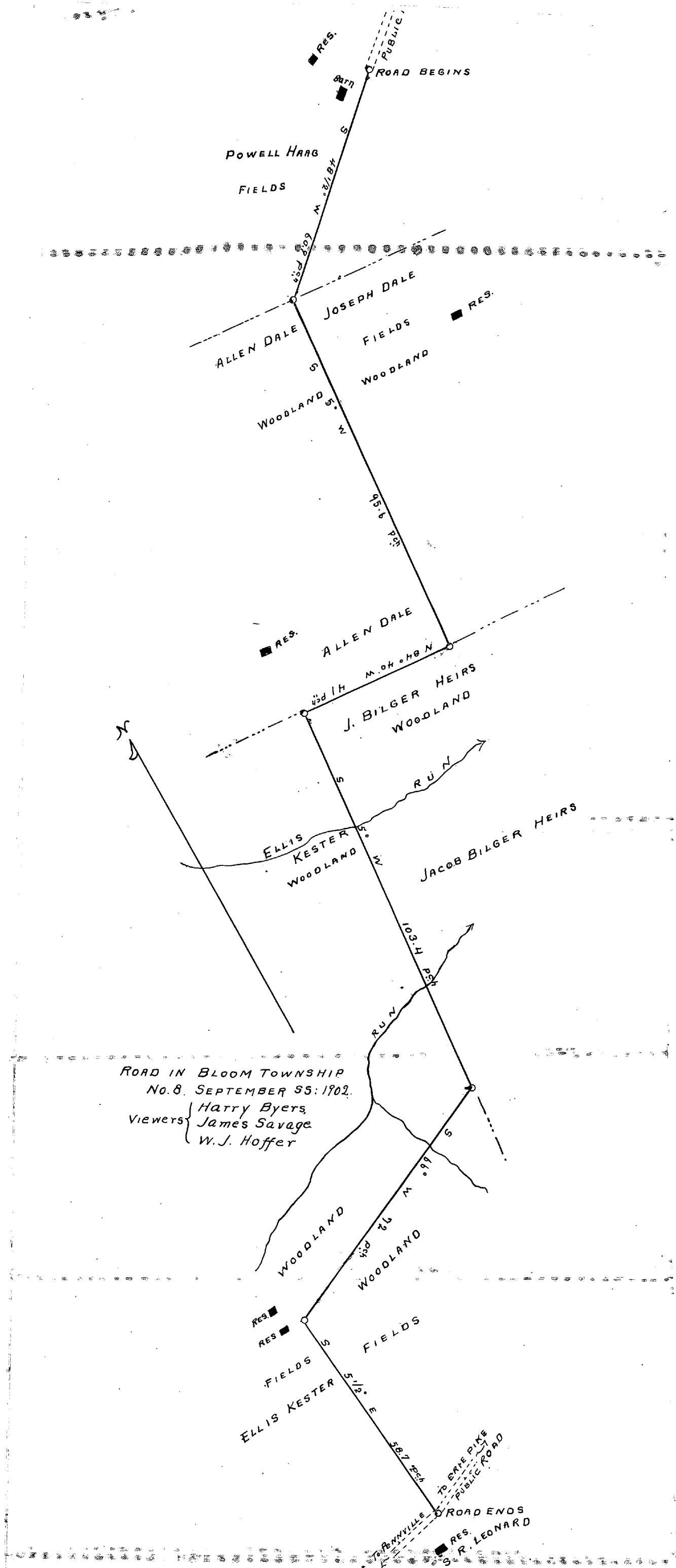

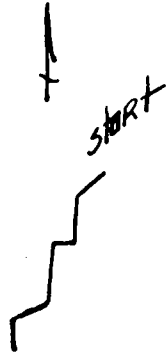

To the Honorable Cyrue Gordon, President Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pa., We, the undersigned viewers appointed by the within order of court to view and lay out the road ^{therein mentioned} respectfully report: that we gave good and lawful notice of said roadview with notice to County Commissioners and Supervisors of Bloom Township attached hereto, all ^{viewers} being present and having been first severally sworn, or affirmed, we have viewed and laid out and do return for public use the following road, to wit: Beginning at public road at Powell Haag's, thence through his improved land South forty-eight and one-half degrees West sixty and nine-tenth perches to a post corner of Joseph and Allen Dale; thence by line between Joseph Dale and Allen Dale through fields and wooded land, South five degrees West ninety-five and six tenth perches to a post on line of Jacob Bilger Heirs' land; thence through wooded land on line between Jacob Bilger Heirs and Allen Dale, North eighty-four degrees and forty minutes West forty-one perches to post; thence continuing through wooded land on line between Jacob Bilger Heirs and Ellis Kester, South five degrees West one hundred and three and four tenth perches to post on said line; thence through wooded and improved land of Ellis Kester, South sixty-six degrees West seventy-two perches to a post; thence by lane of Ellis Kester, South five and one-half degrees East fifty-eight and seven tenth perches to public road at S.
