





We the undersigned viewers appointed to review on view previously made by Messrs. Harry Beyers, James Savage and Aaron Shirey- April 22nd. 1904; to vacate and supply public roads herein mentioned, respectfully report that we gave good and lawful notice of said review to the County Commissioners of Clearfield County, to the Supervisors of Lawrence and Geshen Townships and notices were posted along route of said review.

On May 1st. 1905 as per notices given your viewers met as appointed and all being present were severally affirmed and proceeded to receive testimony and to review to vacate and supply public road herein mentioned.

Your viewers respectfully report that they carefully considered the testimony given in favor of and against the proposed change in roads also examined into the location and benefits of said roads. 




