In the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pa.

The petition of the undersigned, citizens of Glen Hope Borough and of Beccaria Township, in said County, respectfully represents;-

That a public road has long since been laid out and was at one time open for public use, a part of which is now within the said Borough and the balance is within the said township; that the said road is useless, inconvenient and burdensome; and a part thereof has been abandoned by the said Borough as far as is within their power. That a part thereof from a point in the Glen Hope and Ansonville road near the house of Joseph Dickey to a point in the road from Glen Hope to Irvona near Beccaria Mills, and being called the old Mill road, should be vacated; that said road is no longer of service or convenience to the public.

They therefore pray that viewers be appointed to view the same.

Apr 1-1901 Council met and called to order by the President, Dan M. Caldwell. Members present D. M. Caldwell, J. W. Bralton, Jos Baer, Jos Hinkle Wm Dotto. Minutes of last meeting read etc. Committee reports in favor of ordinance vacating road commencing at a point on turnpike leading from Tyrone to Ansonville at the corner of lands of S. C. Patehen and W. S. Dickups Est, and running to Borough line. The same being in the Borough limits. On motion of Dotto and seconded by chair that we except the report of Committee and pass the ordinance to vacate the road. Motion Carried.

May 6-1901 Council met and called to order by President Caldwell. Members present Caldwell, Jos Hinkle, Wm Dotto Robert Caldwell. Minutes of last meeting read etc. On motion of Dotto and seconded by Robert Caldwell that we suspend the rules and pass the Ordinance to vacate the road at once. Motion carried. On motion of Dotto and seconded by Robert Caldwell that we advertise the bill in Coalport Standard in legal form.
