The Petition of the Bradford Township Supervisors respectfully represents:

FIRST: That James K. Nevling and Raymond S. Walker are the owners of a parcel of land situate in Bradford Township, Clearfield County through which a portion of Township Route No. T-617 passes.

SECOND: That the Bradford Township Supervisors wish to vacate a portion of Township Route No. T-617, said portion passing through the above tract.


THIRD: That Bradford Township Supervisors have entered into an agreement dated March *9th*, 1976 with James K. Nevling and Raymond S. Walker, who are in agreement with the Bradford Township Supervisors that the portion of Township Route No. T-617 passing through lands of Walker and Nevling should be vacated, a copy of said agreement is hereto attached and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".

FOURTH: That the map hereto attached and marked Exhibit "B" sets forth in red the area of T-617 to be vacated, and in green,

the newly constructed portion to be designated as New=Township Route No. T-617.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners respectfully request that your Honorable Court enter an order permitting the Bradford Township Supervisors to vacate a portion of T-617 outlined in red on the map and designate and permit a new portion of T-617, outlined in green, to be taken over by the Township as a new public road.


