REPORT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF BRADFORD
TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

TO: The Honorable Court,

The Board of Supervisors of Bradford Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents as follows:

1. That they are the duly elected Supervisors of Bradford Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

2. That the portions of the road to be affected runs as follows:

(a) Being a strip 33 feet in width and 906.48 feet in length running in the direction North 74 degrees 42 minutes East from Route T806 (Old Route 322) to U.S. Route 322, known as TR696.

3. That attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A" is a survey showing the location and width of the roadway.

4. That this roadway was deeded to the Township by undated Quitclaim Deeds of Artie K. Baughman and Viola F. Baughman, and Roland Peters and Bessie Peters, copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibits "B" and "C", respectively.

5. That by Resolution No.30, dated May 4, 1966, the Supervisors of Bradford Township resolved to reopen the herein-before described roadway. A copy of this Resolution is attached hereto as Exhibit "D".

6. That a copy of the Minutes of the meeting of May 4, 1966 of the Bradford Township Supervisors, at which the action accepting this land dedicated by Deed to the Township was taken, is attached hereto as Exhibit "E".

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Bradford Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania would request your Honorable Court to confirm this report as being in line with the provisions of 53 Purdons Statute §66140.


