SANDY TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 85-16

AN ORDINANCE FOR VACATING A PORTION OF
SMITHFIELD STREET IN SANDY TOWNSHIP, CLEAR-
FIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED this 14th day of October, 1985,
that pursuant to Sections 1101 and 1102 of the Second Class Township Code of
1933 and its amendments, the Supervisors of Sandy Township hereby vacate a
portion of Smithfield Street in Sandy Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania,
bounded and described as follows:

I BEGINNING at a point on the Northern right-of-way line of Smithfield Street to an unnamed 16 foot alley, said point also being the Southwest corner of Lot #53 in the George Schwen Plan of Lots in Sandy Township; thence along the Northern right-of-way line of Smithfield Street and Lot #53, North 54° 13' East, 50.50 feet to a point; thence along, Lot #54 and other lands, South 75° 05' 26" East, 159.70 feet to a point on the Northern right-of-way line of South Brady Street; thence along the Northern right-of-way line of South Brady Street, South 27° 37' West, 51.20 feet to a point on said right-of-way line; thence along the Southern line of Smithfield Street, North 75° 05' 26" West, 124.72 feet to a point; thence continuing along the Southern line of Smithfield Street, South 54° 13' West, 26.89 feet to a point on the Southern line of said Street; thence crossing Smithfield Street, North 35° 47' East, 50 feet to a point and the place of beginning. Said portion of street proposed to be vacated contains 9,037.52 square feet or 0.270 acres.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING to the Township of Sandy, its heirs and assigns, rights-of-ways for the installation and maintenance of any and all necessary utilities.

II That pursuant to said proceedings a public meeting was held on October 14, 1985, all interested property owners having been given notice.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED this 14th day of October, 1985.
