

extending thence in a Northerly direction, a distance of 3050 feet
approximately to a point at the Irvona Station of the Pennsylvania &
Northwestern Rail Road, which point is in public street known as
Hopkins street leading from Rail Road Station to the Town of Irvona,

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay
out the same according to law, and report to next term
whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and
appoint C. B. Alexander, Dan M. Caldwell, and Frank E. Rooney,^{Clerk}
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their
appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed
for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers
agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to view and
lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be,
having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in
such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particu-
larly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE
road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances
and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also pro-
cure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass,
or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and
shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for
said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and
affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or
occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of
the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.



TO THE HONORABLE ALLISON O. SMITH, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT
OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

We the undersigned viewers appointed to view for Public Road beginning at the South corner of the school house lot in the village of Wistar in Beccaria Twp. to a point at the Irvona station of the Penna. & Northwestern R.R. which point is in public St. known as Hopkins St. leading from the R.R. station to the town of Irvona, respectfully report that we gave good and lawful notice of said view to the County Commissioners of Clearfield County and to the Supervisors of Beccaria Twp: and notice was served personally on all interested parties possible.

Notices with acceptance of service by same are filed herewith and made a part of this report. Notices were also posted in the vicinity of the proposed road view.

On the 22nd day of July 1904 the date as set forth in the notices as hereunto attached, your viewers met as appointed and being severally affirmed proceeded with a hearing and to view and survey for said road. Your viewers have found that a road is necessary between the points given replacing a private road much traveled between the village and town mentioned, said private road being now practically closed and as same was almost the only outlet for public travel to and from the village of Wistar the residents of that vicinity are much in-convenienced for a means of ingress and egress.

The proposed road has been laid out at a good grade and largely on good solid ground. The greater part of the road can be constructed without great expense.

One stone or wooden culvert and bridge of about 60 feet span over Witmer Run will be required.

Your viewers would therefore respectfully recommend that said road be granted and located as follows:-

Beginning at a point at the South corner of the school house lot in the village of Wistar in Beccaria Twp. thence N.27-55 E. 1225' to a post; thence N. 43-10 E.224' to a post; thence N.58-15 E. 235' to a post; thence S.84-20 E.220' thence along right of way of railroad N.78-55E. 520' to a post; thence N.53-40 E. 600' to a point at the Irvona Station of the Penna. & Northwestern R.R. which point is in public St. known as Hopkins Street leading from the R.R. station to the town of Irvona in Beccaria Township, being about 3024 feet in length. A plan of which road is hereunto attached and made a part of this report.

Also—Viewers will carefully note the number of days employed and set the amount out at the foot of their return.
Viewers cannot interfere with damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the viewers.
NOTE.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.
