87-2-Road

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD T -327 SITUATE IN BELL TOWNSHIP, TO WIT THAT PORTION WHICH BEGINS AT AN INTERSECTION OF U.S.219 BETWEEN STATION 6/05 and 5/00 GOING IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION FOR A DISTANCE OF 1,570'.

WHEREAS, the said route has become of no value as a public road,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 1102(a) of the Second Class Township Code, ten days written notice has been given to the property owners affected thereby of the time and place of the public hearing to consider the vacation, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 1102(e) of the Second Class Township Code, notice of a public hearing for the purpose of considering said vacation was advertised in the Clearfield Progress on July 29, 1987, setting forth that a hearing would be held by the Bell Township Supervisors on August 11, 1987, and

WHEREAS, The Bell Township Supervisors did hold said meeting at the time and date aforesaid, and

WHEREAS, as a result of said hearing, the Bell Township Supervisors are of the opinion that said township road is not needed as a public highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Bell Township hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. That the portion of Township Road T-327, to wit that portion which begins at an intersection of U.S.219 between station 6/05 and 5/00 going in an easterly direction for a distance of 1,570', be and is hereby vacated.
