AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC MUNICIPAL
STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF CURWENSVILLE, AN
ADDITION TO THE STREET KNOWN AS IRVIN ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Curwensville and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by Authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the following addition to the street which is known as Irvin Road, is hereby ordained as a public municipal street in the Borough of Curwensville.

BEGINNING at a point at the terminus of ordained Irvin Road, said point being in the center line of its 33 foot width; thence by the center line of the proposed extension these following courses and distances; North 36° 00' 16" East, a distance of 178.50 feet; thence North 22° 34' 33" East, a distance of 163.00 feet; thence North 10° 36' 28" East, a distance of 156.75 feet to a point in the center line of Cooper Road extension. Said proposed extension of Irvin Road having a total length of 498.25 feet with 25 feet on either side of the above described center line and parallel therewith throughout its entire length and having a total width of 50.00 feet. Situate in the Borough of Curwensville, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION TWO: That the aforesaid addition to said street having been heretofore opened and utilized by the general public and designated as such upon the maps of the Borough of Curwensville, the grade of said street shall be as existing or required for Borough purposes for the improvement thereof.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be effective Thirty (30) days after enactment.

SECTION FOUR: All ordinances and resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
