AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION IN
GRAMPIAN BOROUGH OF A PORTION OF TENTH STREET
FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH U.S. ROUTE 218 NORTH
TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH GROVE STREET AND ALSO
FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF PARK AVENUE
FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH U.S. ROUTE 219 TO
ITS INTERSECTION WITH NINTH STREET.

WHEREAS, the said routes have become of no value as
public roads, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 1741 and 1742 of
the Borough Code, all but one of the owners of abutting real
estate joined into a petition to vacate the said streets
and waived any rights to damages under Section 1742 and 1743 of
the Borough Codes, and

WHEREAS, at least fifteen days personal notice was
given to the one adjoining owner who did not join in the said
petition, and

WHEREAS, at least fifteen days notice of a public
hearing to be held on September 6, 1994 to consider the proposed
vacations was given by publication on August 13, 1994 in the
Clearfield Progress, a newspaper of general circulation in
Grampian Borough, and

WHEREAS, the Grampian Borough Council did hold said
hearing at the time and date aforesaid, and

WHEREAS, as a result of said hearing, the Grampian
Borough Council is of the opinion that said roads are not
needed as public highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Grampian Borough Council hereby, orders as follows:

Section 1 - That the portion of Tenth Street from its intersection with U.S. Route 219 north to its intersection with Grove Street, be and is hereby vacated.

Section 2 - That the portion of Park Avenue from its intersection with U.S. Route 219 east to its intersection with Ninth Street, be and is hereby vacated.

Section 3 - It is not the intention of this Ordinance to affect in any manner, any rights of way heretofore granted to utilities or any private rights acquired by individuals.

This ordinance shall be effective thirty days from the date of enactment.
