Pursuant to the provisions of 75 PA C.S. Chapter 92, TRANSFER OF STATE HIGHWAYS, the portions of the following State Routes located in Morris Township are hereby deleted from the State System.

HEREIN INCLUDED:

SR 2032 (LR 17113) from segment 0070, offset 0000 (station 168+75) to segment 0090 offset 2396 (station 273+58), a distance of 10,459 feet or 1.9809 miles.

HEREIN EXCLUDED:

16' box culvert and approach area from segment 0084/offset 0000 to segment 0084/offset 0016, BMSID No. 17/2032/0084/0000.

HEREIN INCLUDED:

SR 2035 (LR 17079) from segment 0010 offset 0000 (station 15+30) to segment 0010 offset 1883 (station 33+05), a distance of 1,883 feet or 0.3566 miles.

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Morris Township

HEREIN INCLUDED:

SR 2045 from segment 0010 offset 0000 to segment 0010 offset 0636, a distance of 636 feet or 0.1204 miles.

This action is taken with the concurrence of the Township.

As of December 31, 1994, the responsibility for maintenance, construction and reconstruction of the portions of highways described above reverts to the Township. These portions of highways will not be placed on the Township's mileage system for Liquid Fuels Tax Reimbursement under Act 655 of 1956, for April 1, 1995; however, beginning on April 1, 1996, annual payments will be made in the amount of \$6,150.00 under PA C.S. 9511(g). This amount is based on the \$2500 per lineal mile payable under provisions of the Department's Highway Transfer Program.

The Engineering District 2-0 Highway Turnback Coordinator will provide the Township with copies of the straight-line diagrams, all available right-of-way information, and will be happy to furnish any personal assistance needed.

NOTE: It is important that you provide a copy of this legal transfer of ownership to the Office in the County Courthouse which is responsible for Municipal Road Dockets and that you furnish the Department, through the Engineering District, with proof that the transfer has been recorded in the County Courthouse. The Department will not begin making the annual payments under 75 PA C.S. 9511(g) unless and until it receives proof that the transfer has been duly recorded in the Courthouse.

The Department of Transportation appreciates your cooperation.
