**REPORT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
GULICH TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

TO THE HONORABLE COURT:

The Board of Supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania,
respectfully represents as follows:

1. That they are the duly elected Supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield
County, Pennsylvania.

2. That the unnamed alley vacated is as follows:

ALL that certain piece or parcel of land situate in the Village
of Janesville, Gulich Township, Clearfield County,
Pennsylvania, consisting of an unnamed alley shown on the
Plan of Janesville fronting twenty (20') feet on Oak Street
and extending back in a uniform width two hundred (200')
feet to an alley and being bounded on the North by said Oak
Street, on the East by Lot No. 120, now Assessment Map
No. 118-O-K16-511-00020, on the South by an alley and
on the West by Lot No. 118, now Assessment Map No.
118-O-K16-511-00019.

3. That attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A" is

a plot from the Clearfield County Assessment Map with the area having been vacated being marked in red.

4. That in the judgment of the Board of Supervisors, it is a benefit to the Township to vacate said unnamed alley as it has never been opened or maintained by the Township, there appears to be no benefit to any future opening and alternative routes are readily available.

5. That the abutting property owners on the West are Frank Saupp and Nancy Saupp, who originally requested that the Township vacate said alley and who were personally served with a copy of the Notice of the proposed enactment of the Ordinance affecting said alley on June 6, 1999. Copy of said Notice is attached hereto and made a part of this Report, designated as Exhibit "B".

6. That the abutting property owners on the East are Robert Martin and Virginia Martin who were personally served with a copy of the Notice of the proposed enactment of the Ordinance affecting said alley on June 6, 1999. Copy of said Notice is attached hereto and made a part of this Report, designated as Exhibit "C".

7. That the property owners across an alley on the South is the Janesville Methodist Church which was personally served with a copy of the Notice of the proposed enactment of the Ordinance affecting said alley on June 13, 1999. Copy of said Notice is attached hereto and made a part of this Report, designated as Exhibit "D".

8. That pursuant to said Notice and following advertisement as required by law, the Board of Supervisors of Gulich Township did enact an Ordinance No. 7-1-99, copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "E" on July 1, 1999.

9. That prior to the enactment of said Ordinance, a hearing was held at the Gulich Township Building, Gulich Township, on July 1, 1999 at 6:30 p.m. at which time no objections to the proposed vacating of said roadway and alley were raised.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
GULICH TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING A PORTION OF AN
UNNAMED ALLEY BOUNDED BY OAK STREET AND LOTS
118 AND 120, JANESVILLE, GULICH TOWNSHIP.

The Board of Supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania
enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION I

DECLARATION OF PURPOSE

Section 1.01: WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code, (53 P.S. §67304) permits township supervisors to enact, ordain, survey, lay out, open, widen, straighten, vacate and relay all roads within the Township; and

Section 1.02: WHEREAS, the property owner adjoining the alley to be vacated has petitioned the Township to close and vacate any claim which the Township may have to said alley; and

Section 1.03: WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of Supervisors, it is a benefit to the Township to vacate any claim to said unnamed alley, as same has never been opened nor maintained by the Township and there appears to be no benefit to the Township for any future opening and alternate routes being readily available.

SECTION II

VACATION

Section 2.01: The Township hereby vacates the unnamed alley which is bounded and described as follows:

ALL that certain piece or parcel of land situate in the Village
of Janesville, Gulich Township, Clearfield County,
Pennsylvania, consisting of an unnamed alley shown on the
Plan of Janesville fronting twenty (20') feet on Oak Street
and extending back in a uniform width two hundred (200')

feet to an alley and being bounded on the North by said Oak Street, on the East by Lot No. 120, now Assessment Map No. 118-O-K16-511-00020, on the South by an alley and on the West by Lot No. 118, now Assessment Map No. 118-O-K16-511-00019.

Section 2.02: That the portion of the unnamed alley to be vacated is shown on a plot from the Clearfield County Assessment Map which is attached hereto, with the area to be vacated being marked in red.

SECTION III

EFFECTIVE DATE

Section 3.01: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the date of enactment.





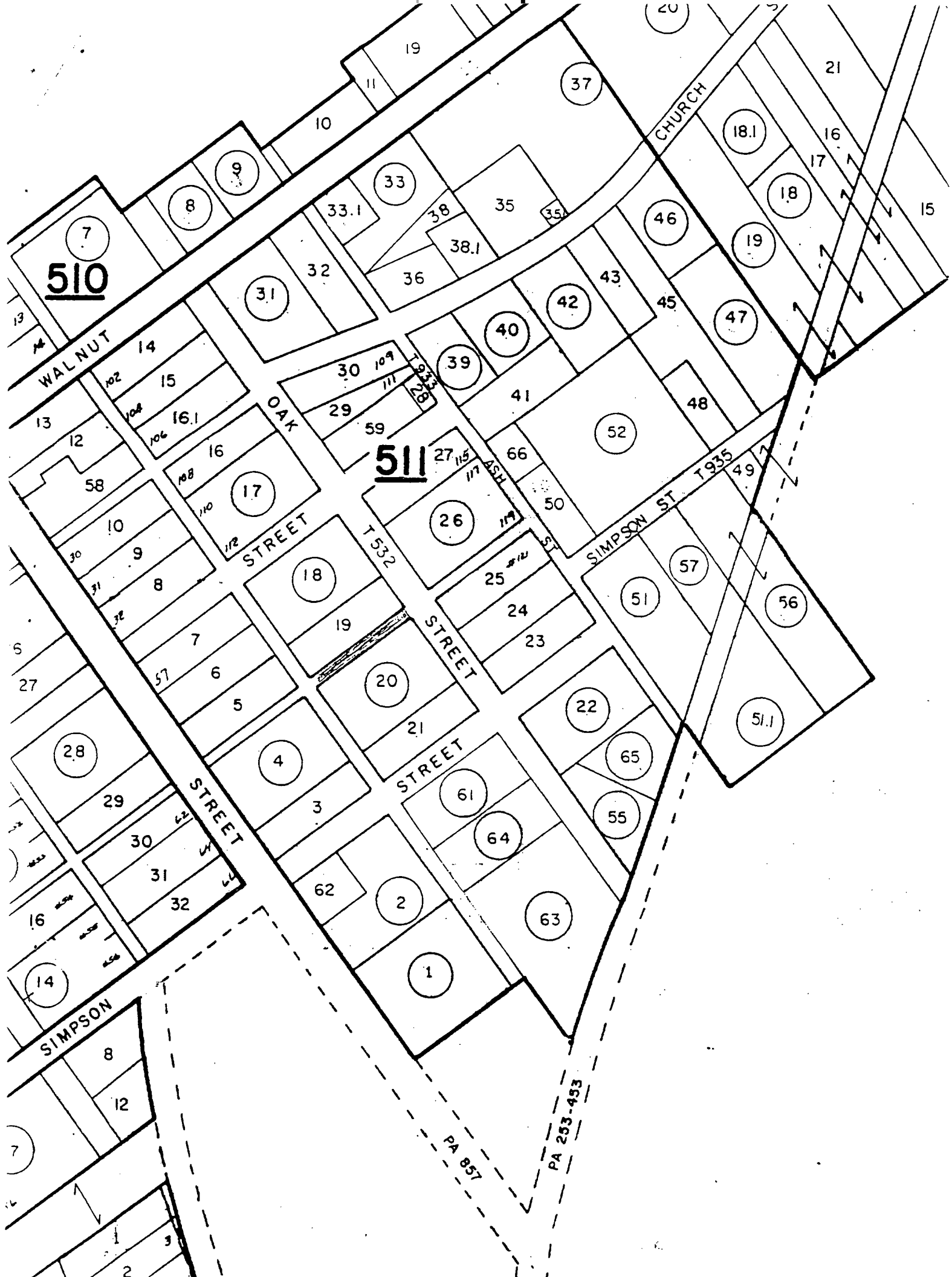
