AN ORDINANCE OF LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, filed to
PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING TOWNSHIP STREETS KNOWN AS HARRIET STREET Civil case
AND BROOK STREET UPON PETITION PURSUANT TO SECTION 2304 OF THE
SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors
of the Township of Lawrence, and it is hereby enacted and
ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

WHEREAS, a Petition in writing has been presented to
the Board of Supervisors of Lawrence Township, Clearfield
County, Pennsylvania, by and on behalf of Petitioner, residents
and/or landowners within the Township, surrounding and abutting
the streets known as Harriet Street and Brook Street, requesting
that the Township Supervisors vacate said streets; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence Township Supervisors gave public
notice and written notice to the owners adjacent to Harriet
Street and Brook Street ten (10) days prior to the hearing that
was held on December 18, 2001 at 2:15 p.m. to inquire into the
merits of vacating Harriet Street and Brook Street;

AND WHEREAS, after public hearing at which no one
appeared to object to said action, the Board of Supervisors are
of the opinion that said Harriet Street and Brook Street is not
necessary to the public and is not usable in its present
condition, and the repairs needed to make said streets safe for
travel and the maintenance of same would present an unnecessary
and undue hardship upon the Township.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

1. That Harriet Street and Brook Street be and it is
hereby vacated, closed and removed from the Lawrence Township
Road System.

2. The Lawrence Township Secretary is directed to
record this Ordinance together with the attached map of the
street being vacated in the Prothonotary's Office of the Court
of Common Pleas, of Clearfield County.

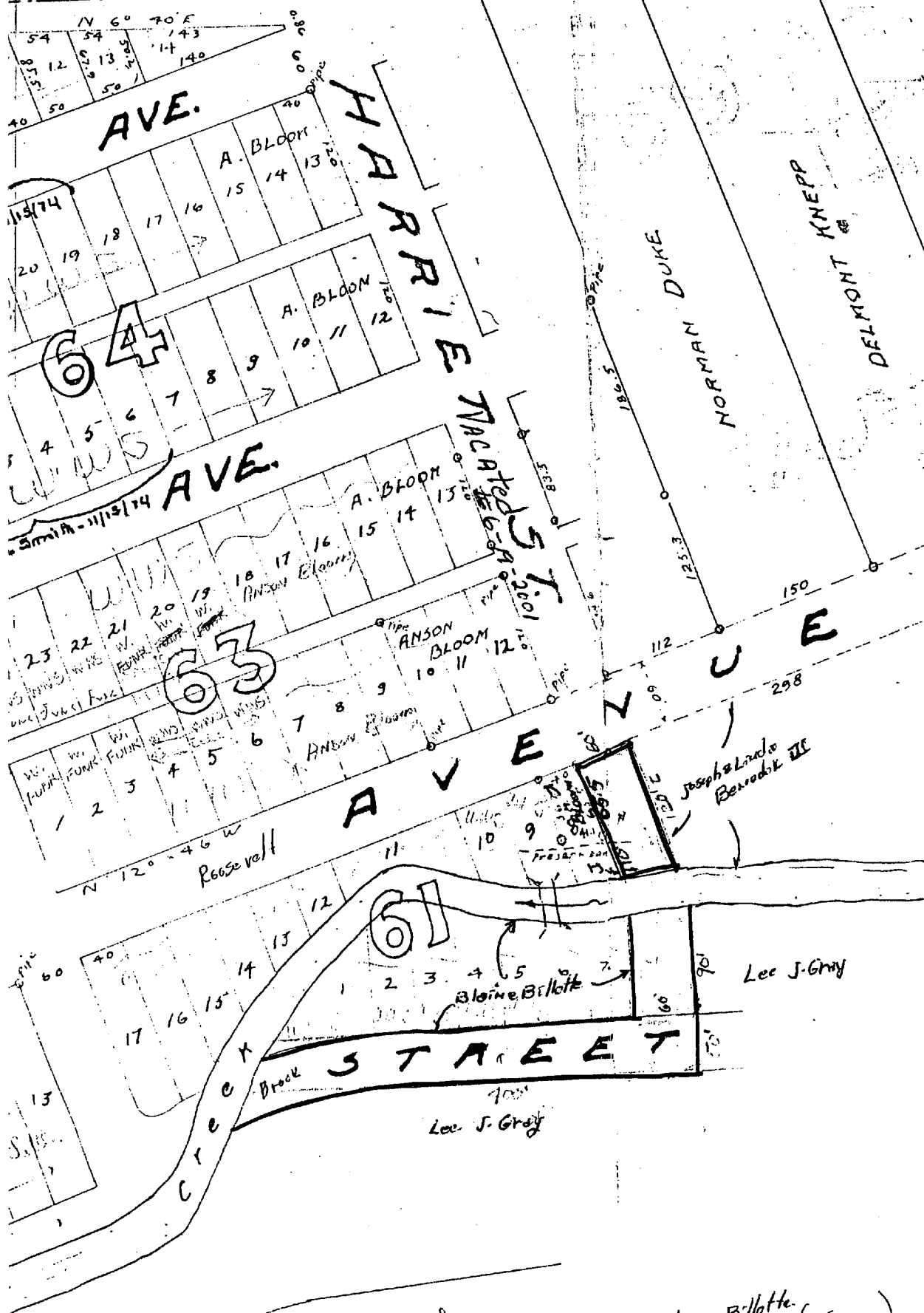
