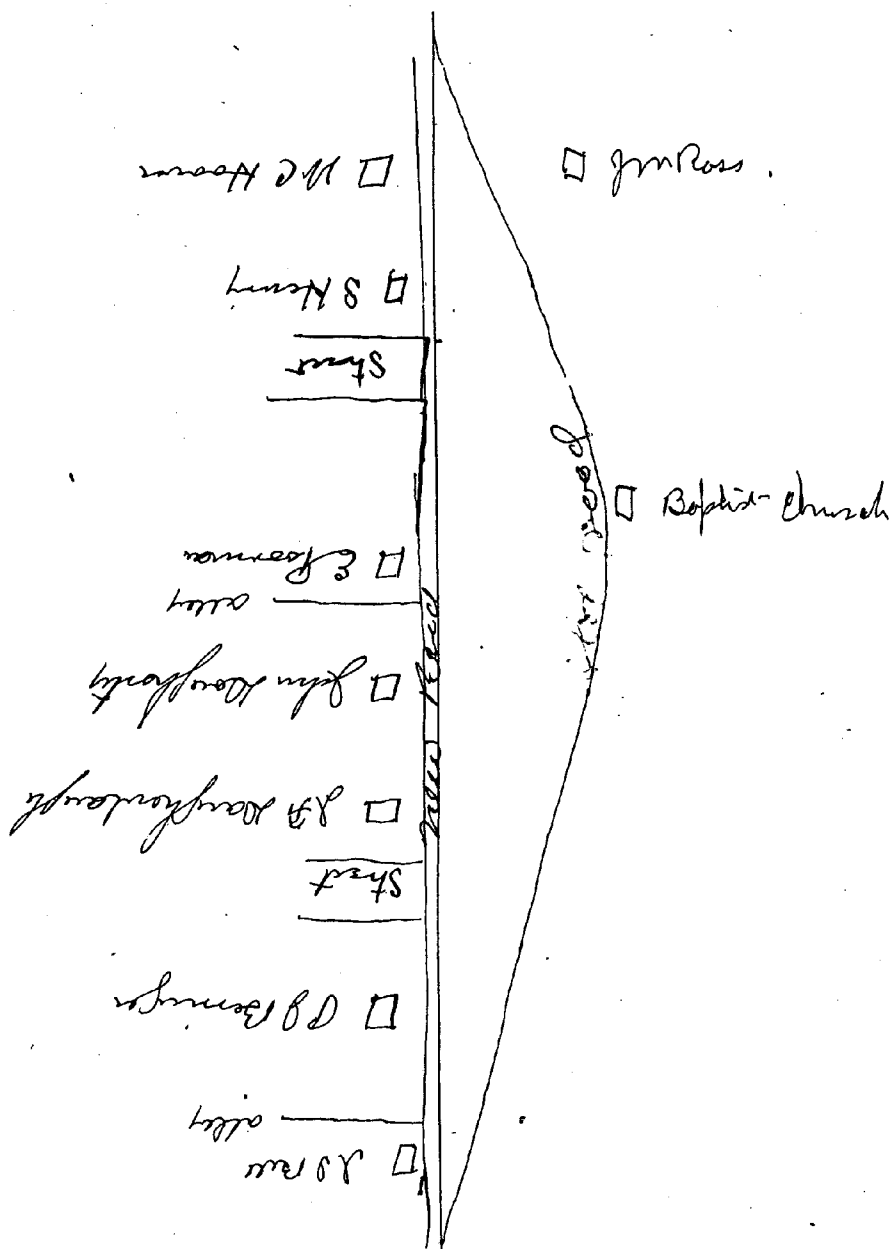

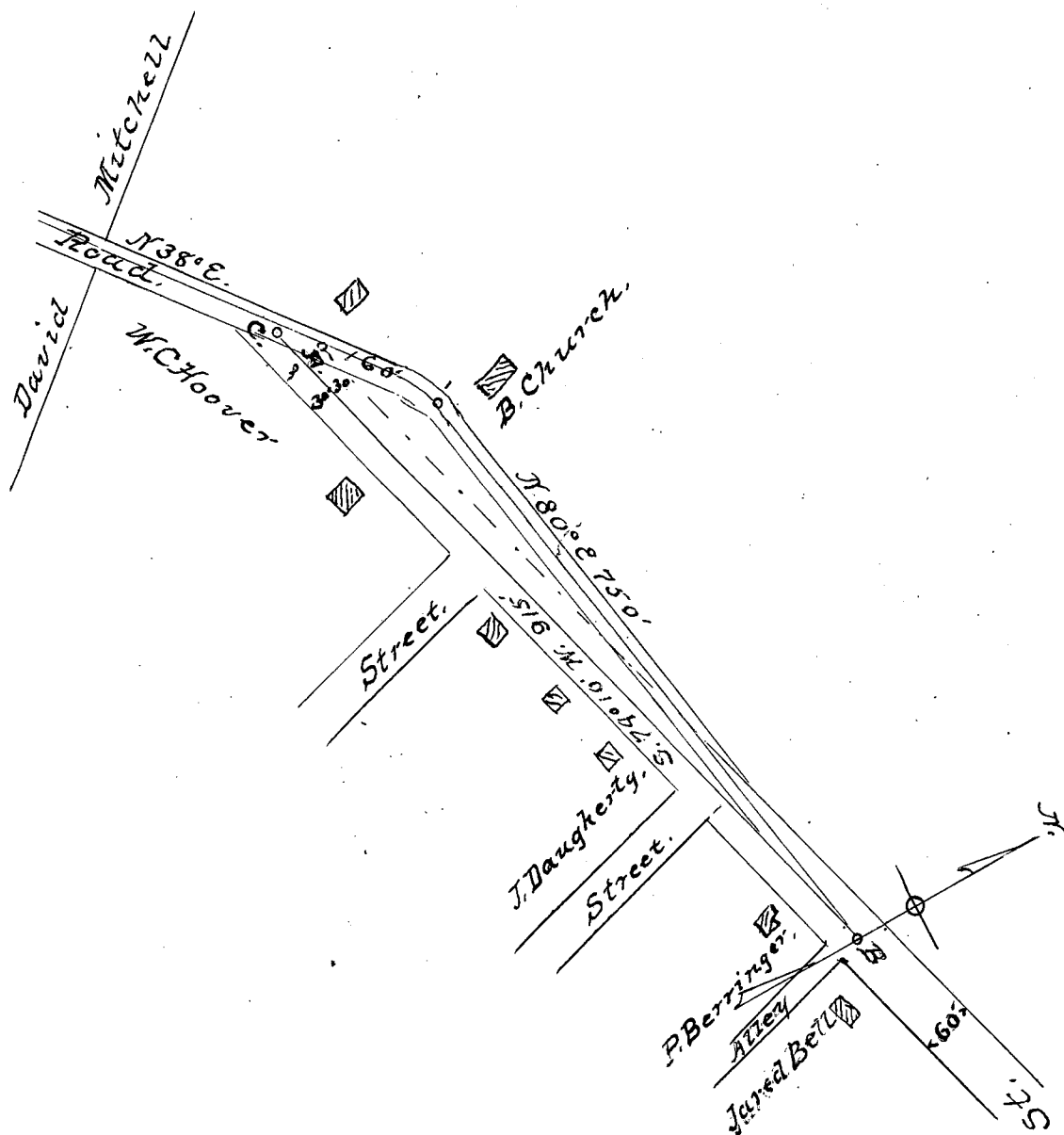

Horvath 60 ft from line of lots, thence along road North  $38^{\circ}$  East 160 ft. still along center of road North  $80^{\circ}$  East 750 feet to point at center of 60 ft street opposite alley line of Jacob Bell. Supplying to conform with center of said street - Beginning at "B" thence South  $74^{\circ} 10'$  West 915 feet to point "C" in center of Public road 30 ft from lot line of W.C. Horvath.
