AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF AN UNKNOWN ALLEY OFF  
OF SPRING STREET IN LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, Gary L. Hepburn and Debra S. Hepburn have  
petitioned the Lawrence Township Supervisors to vacate a sixteen  
(16') foot unknown alley off of Spring Street which alley  
extends West from Spring Street toward High Street and ends at  
an unnamed 20 foot wide North/South unopened alley, said alley  
also runs parallel with, and lies to the south of unopened Helen  
Street; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence Township Supervisors have given  
public notice and notice to the owner adjacent to the unknown  
alley ten (10) days in advance of the hearing that was held on  
March 16, 2004 at 2:15 p.m. to inquire into the merits of  
vacating the unknown alley;

AND WHEREAS, the hearing was held and no one appeared  
to object to said action.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

1. That a sixteen (16) foot wide unknown alley off of  
Spring Street be and is hereby vacated and closed and removed  
from the Township road system.

2. The Lawrence Township Secretary is directed to  
record this Ordinance together with the attached draft of the  
alley being vacated in the Prothonotary's Office of the Court of  
Common Pleas, of Clearfield County.
