Vacate Public Road

To the Hon. Allison O. Smith, President Judge of the Court
of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield county, Pa.

The petition of the undersigned citizens of the township
of Pike, in said county, respectfully represents;

That a road has long since been laid out leading from
the borough of Clearfield to the borough of Curwensville,
passing through the townships of Lawrence and Pike, known' as
the River road. That a part of said road, within the bounds
of Pike township, about one mile in length, of the width of
sixteen feet more or less, and extending from a point, the
line between Lawrence and Pike townships, near the site of
the old Schmarrs mill, and between the tracks of the B. R. &
P. Ry. and the west branch of the Susquehanna river, to a po
point in Pike township opposite the barn of Jefferson Bloom,
has become dangerous and inconvenient, owing to the constant
passing of trains and its proximity to the river, and expen-
sive and burdensome to the taxpayers of said township to
maintain. Your petitioners further represent that a
safe and convenient road has already been opened up and is
in use as directed and ordered by your Honorable Court(vide
No. 3 Sept Sess 1892).

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court that the said part
of road, to wit; from township line near old Schmarrs mill to
a point in said road opposite the barn of Jefferson Bloom may
be vacated agreeably to the Act of Assembly in such case made
and provided.
