Your petitioner John A. Otto, Executor of John
B. Otto deceased, respectfully presents,

That he is at great
inconvenience for want of a private road to be used in
most part as a timber road to lead from tract of
land No 5067 in the name of "Wm Powers," belonging to the
Estate of John B. Otto, deceased, to Bernetts' Branch
of the Sinnemaahoning and thence across to the township
road at the property late belonging to Philip Hevener,
but now to Dr. C. R. Early, being a distance of about
One and a half miles more or less, all in Huston
township, Clearfield County Pa. —

He therefore prays the appointment of
viewers to view, and lay out such road according
to law. — And so he will pray. —
