your petitioners labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway in the Twp of Cooper to begin at a point near A. J. Kellogg's store, Grassfield, on Public Road leading from Kylertown to Peale in Cooper Twp. to a point near Moravian Rift on road leading from Peale to Cooper Settlement.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view ^{and lay} out the same according to law, Report to next term whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint C. B. Alexander J. F. Gosd and A. C. Lunsberry who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to view ^{and} lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

TO THE HONORABLE ALLISON O. SMITH, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT
OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

We the undersigned Viewers for Public Road herein mentioned,
respectfully report that we gave good and lawful notice of said view to
the County Commissioners of Clearfield county, to the Supervisors of
Cooper Twp., to the property owners along route of said view and notices
were posted in the vicinity of view. Copies of notices with signatures
are herewith attached.

On July 24th. 1906 as per notices given your Viewers met as
appointed and being severally affirmed, proceeded to receive testimony
and to view for said Public Road.

Your Viewers have found this proposed road as shown on the map
attached and made a part of this report to be largely on the streets of
the Village of Grass Flat and will accommodate a number of citizens
living thereon and adjacent. The road can be built on a reasonably good
grade and with no part being of excessive cost to construct.

No objections to granting this road was offered your Viewers
at place and time of view. Your Viewers believe this road will be of
use to the community for which it is petitioned and to the public equiv-
alent to or greater than the cost of construction and would therefore
recommend it as petitioned and laid out Viz.

Beginning at a point near A.F. Kelley's Store at Grass flat in
Public Road leading from Kylertown to Peale; Thence by a street N. 4-30 E. 715'
to a point at intesection of said street with Clearfield street;
Thence S. 85-30 E. 2000' by Clearfield Street to a point; Thence S. 71-00
E. 443' to a point; Thence S. 73-00 E. 292' to a point; Thence S. 78-10 E.
313' to a point; Thence S. 71-00 E. 451' to a point near Moravian drift
on road leading from Peale to Cooper Settlement.

Should it be desirable to widen this road to its full width of
33' on the 30' street on which it located in part, your Viewers would
recommend that 1-1/2' be added to each side of said street without dama-
ges as we believe the placing of this public road will be of value to
abutting properties greater than the damage done.

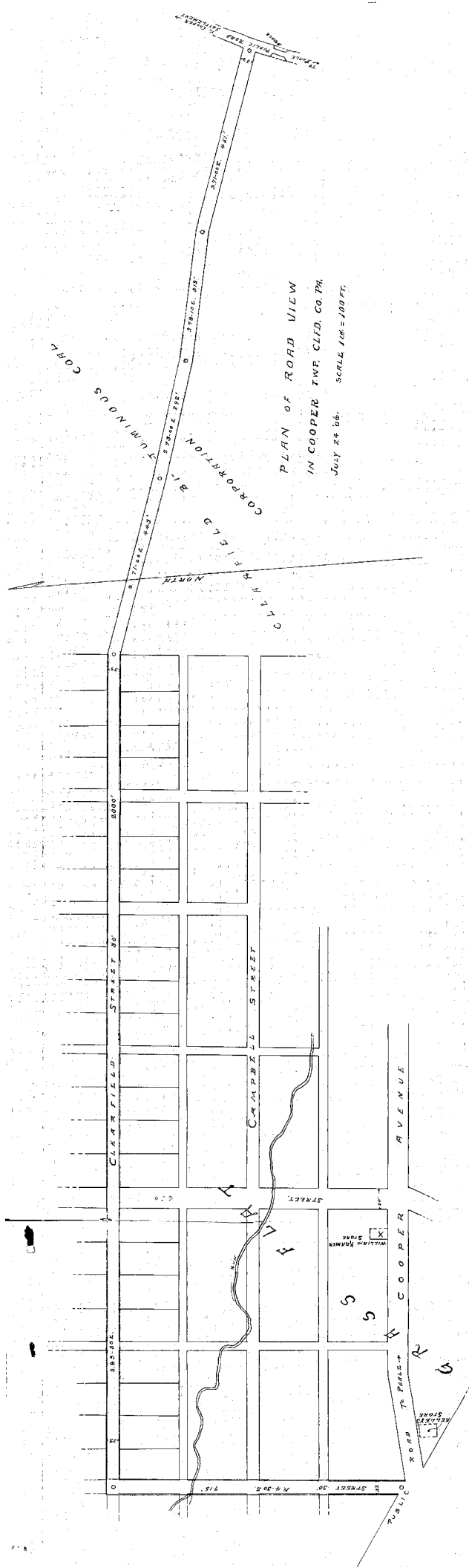
