TO THE HONORABLE ALLISON O. SMITH, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT
OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

We the undersigned Viewers for Public Road herein mentioned respectfully report that we gave good and lawful notice of said view to the County Commissioners of Clearfield County, to the Supervisors of Bigler Twp. to the property owners along route of said view and notices were posted in the vicinity of view all according to law. Copies of notices with signatures are herewith attached.

On July 21st. 1906 as per notices given your Viewers met as appointed and being severally affirmed, proceeded to receive testimony and to view for said Public Road.

Your Viewers have found a well travelled road already in place on the location proposed for Public Road, which with slight changes can be made into a Public Road with reasonably good grade.

This proposed road will form a short connecting link between two main roads and will be a great convenience to a number of citizens of that neighborhood and to the travelling public.

No objections to granting this road was offered your viewers at time and place of view. Your Viewers would therefore respectfully recommend its adoption and construction where necessary Viz:

Beginning at a point at lands of Jacob Ferlish in Public Road leading from Mine No. 18 to Amesville; Thence by a street S. 29-30 W. 312' to a point; Thence S. 66-50 W. 139' to a point; Thence N. 86-50 W. 102' to a point; Thence S. 88-00 W. 305' to a point; Thence S. 24-40 W. 200' to a point; Thence S. 56-00 W. 190' to a point; Thence S. 65-40 W. 266' to a point; Thence S. 71-15 W. ^{22'} to a point at lands of D.C. Hensal in a Public Road leading from Amesville to Madera.

A plot of this road is herewith attached and made a part of this report.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 21st day of June, A. D. 1901, before the Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Inglen

in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road to begin at a point at the lands of Jacob Ferlisch in a public road leading from Amessville to Mine M 18 and extending thence to a point at the lands of D C Kussel in another public road leading from Amessville to Madera

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view Elay ^{Elay}
out the same according to law, whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint W. C. Alley and W. C. Langford and D. M. C. Cushing who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed

agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of sealed land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.
