At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 14th day of Dec, A. D. 1906, before the Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Girard, in said county, setting forth that

about 35 years ago, a road was laid out without any view, the same leading from Humphreys Steam Mill to a point on public road or near the Old Buck Run School House, that said road, by reason of its having been worked on by the supervisors, and used by the public has become a public highway, that the same now is useless and burdensome to keep up, and that a better road can be obtained than what the present road is. They therefore pray your said Court to appoint viewers to view and locate that portion of the above road from the Old Buck Run School House to a point or near the fields of Serdon Royer

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view locate ~~and~~ supply the same according to law, Report to May Term whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Harry Reese, August Rougeau, Ed. L. Shiey who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed view locate and supply agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

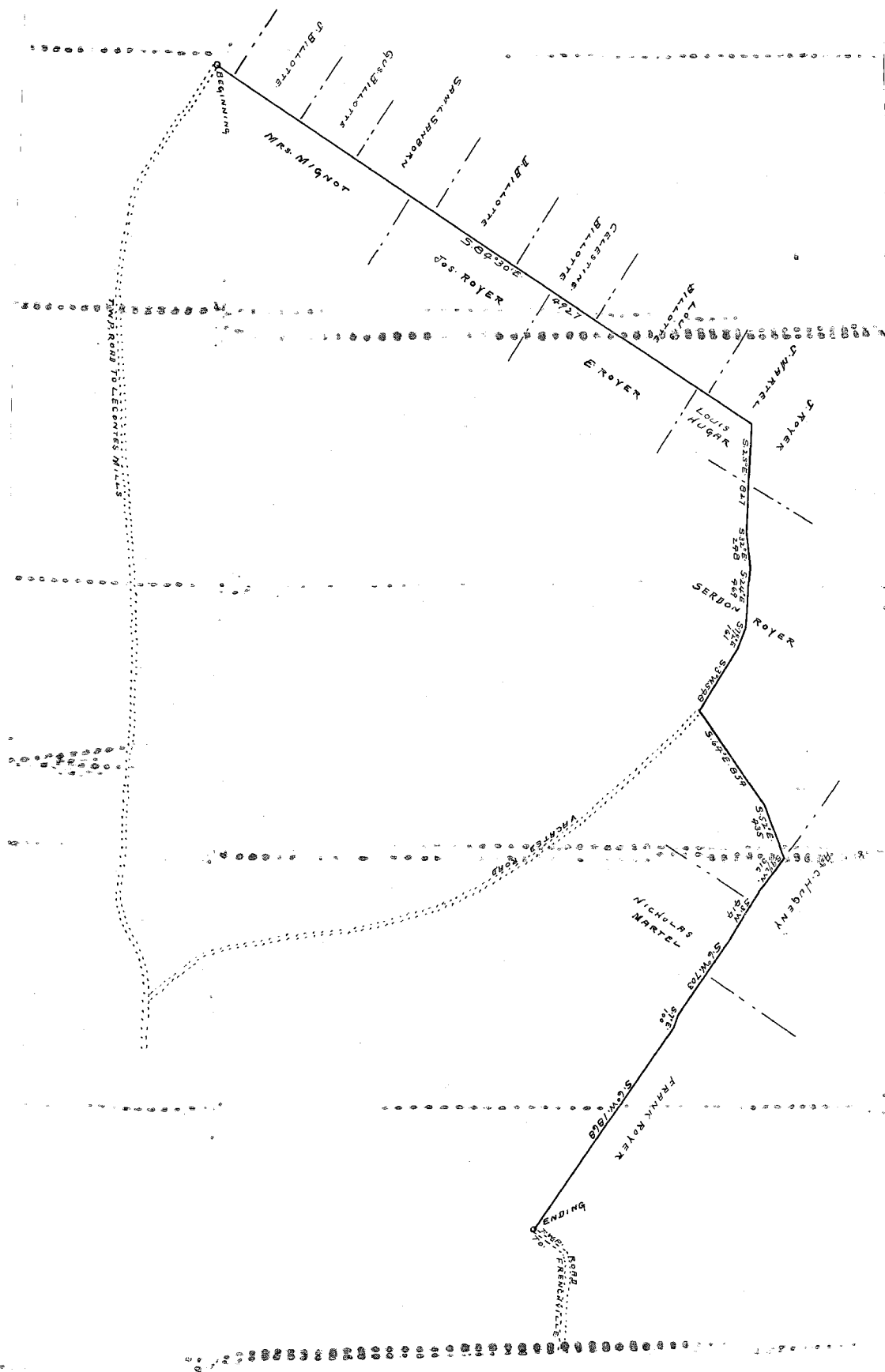

We the undersigned persons
appointed by the Within order of Court
to view and lay out the road therein
mentioned respectfully report that
after having given due public notice by
three written and printed notices put
up near the location of said road of the
time and place of meeting to view and
lay out the same and having also given
due notice to the County Commissioners and
the supervisors of Girard Township of the
said time and place of meeting we met
at the Old Buck Run School house in
Girard Township on Friday the 19th day
of April A.D. 1907 and after having been
duly affirmed in pursuance of the
Within order we proceeded to view
and lay out and do return for public
use the following road to wit-

Beginning at a post at the northern terminus
of the public road running from LeConte's
mills to the Billotte place. Thence running
South eighty four and one half degrees East
Four thousand nine hundred and twenty seven

feet. Thence South twenty-five degrees East
Eight hundred and twenty seven feet. Thence
South thirty-two feet East two hundred and
forty-eight feet. Thence South twenty-four
degrees East four hundred and sixty nine
feet. Thence South seven and one half
degrees East one hundred and sixty one
feet. Thence South three degrees West five
hundred and forty eight feet. Thence
South sixty four degrees East Eight Hun-
dred and fifty-four feet. Thence South
fifty-two degrees East four hundred
and thirty five feet. Thence South nine
degrees and thirty-Minutts West three
hundred and sixteen feet. Thence
South three degrees West four hun-
dred and fourteen feet. Thence South
six degrees West seven hundred
and three feet. Thence South seven
degrees East one hundred feet.
