Thomas Hemphill and Mrs. Espy Spencer by their
Attorneys, Bell & Hartswick, file the following exceptions to
the proceedings in this case, for matters appearing of record.

First: The petition and order to view name an inter-
mediate point in the route of the proposed new road, between
the termini thereof, viz: "the intersection of Washington Avenue
and Fullerton Street."

Second: The southern terminus of said proposed new
road is fixed in the petition and order to view at 650 feet
from the Railroad crossing, and the view located it 800 feet
from said Crossing and 150 feet from the proposed terminus.

Third: The petition asks for the vacation of two
disconnected parts of one road and a part of another road.

Fourth: The report of the viewers vacates a part
of one road running from McPherson's to the River and two dis-
connected parts of another road, leaving the middle part there-
of stand as a public road with its termini ending on private
property.


Fifth: The vacation is so made as to entirely cut
off access to the dwelling house of Mrs. Espy Spencer.

To the Honorable Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the Township of Lawrence, in the County aforesaid respectfully represents; That, they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road to begin at the west end of Boggs Fording Bridge across the river South of Clearfield, thence by way of the intersection of Washington Avenue and Fullerton Street to a point on public road leading from said Bridge to Curwensville, about 650 feet above Railroad crossing at Mrs. Espy Spencers, in said Township. The petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three persons qualified according to law, to view the ground proposed for such road, and, if they see occasion to lay out the same, to inquire of and vacate the public road now opened from said Boggs Fording Bridge to Curwensville:

First, That part of said road leading from said Bridge, at the west end, to corner of land of Frank Smith and Clearfield Steel and Iron Co.

Second. That part of said road leading from East side of B. R. & P. R. R. crossing at house of Mrs. Espy Spencer to point about 650 feet towards Curwensville from said crossing.

Also to vacate part of road leading from first mentioned road proposed to be vacated to Jas. McPhersons. The part desired to be vacated begins at said road at river and ends at Washington Avenue.
