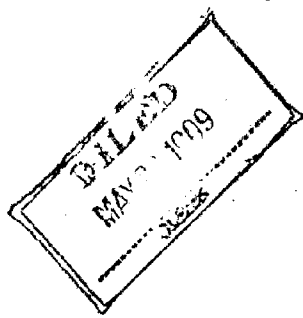

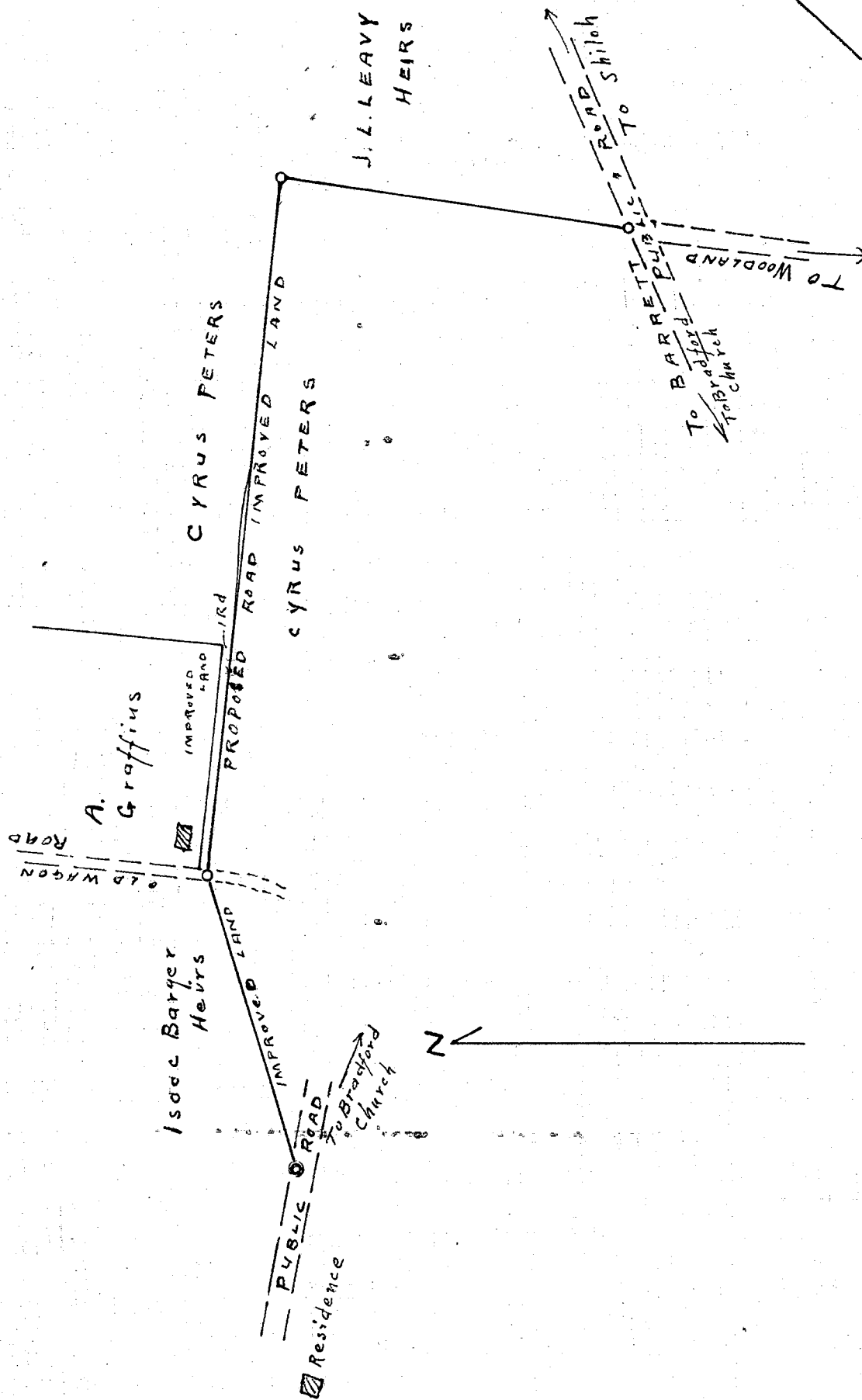

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 23rd day of May, A. D. 1908, before the Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bradford, in said county, setting forth that

there was a public road long since laid out extending from Pleasant Valley in Bradford Township and connecting at a point near the old Bradford Church on public road leading from Barrett to Shiloh; that a portion of said road from a point at or near the Bradford Church to a point at or near the house of Isaac Barger, is steep and in winter time is impassible on account of drifts and expensive to keep up.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view ^{vacate & supply} that portion of said road between a point at or near Isaac Barger residence to a point on the Shiloh road at or near Bradford Church, ~~the same~~ according to law,

whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Harry Byers, Leander Denning and ~~Franklin Denning~~ ^{J. A. McPherson} who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such ^{vacation &} road, they shall proceed to view ^{vacate & supply} agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.

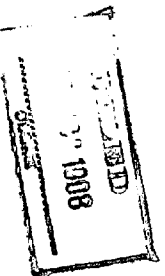
