





D. 1908, before the Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Boggs, in said county, setting forth that the petitioners labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road leading from Litz's Bridge to David Flegal's, at a point on said road near Litz's Bridge in the Township of Boggs and to the end at a public road known as the Erie Pike leading from Blueball to Cermwensville at a point on the said Public Road near the farm of Robert McGaughey, in the Township of Boggs; the petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint proper persons to view the ground proposed for such road, and if they should see occasion to lay out the same to inquire of and vacate the public road now opened from Litz Bridge aforesaid to a point at or near Coal Run Hollow on the line of the proposed road in the Township of Boggs which last mentioned road will, by reason of the laying out of the proposed road, become useless,

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view the same according to law, whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint J. S. McCreery, Leander Denning and J. M. Bloom who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to view, vacate and supply agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

To The Honorable Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by your Honorable Court, as per accompanying order, this day met according to notices legally served and posted, and having ^{been} affirmed according to law, viewed the proposed route for supply, as well as the road to be vacated, and having considered the available testimony, find that the road now in use, ^{is} utterly impracticable and burdensome, on account of steepness of the grade, (in some places being 14°, much of it exceeding 10°) and being over the point of an abrupt hill, must necessarily be subject to snow-drifts in the winter, that it is not necessary as an outlet, and is exceedingly hard to maintain; while the proposed route surveyed for supply provides an excellent grade, will be easy to construct and maintain, and is in every way a desirable change. We therefore unanimously recommend the vacation and supply asked for by your petitioners, as set forth by the following notes of survey, and accompanying draft, which is a part of this report.

For Supply--Beginning at a point on public road 250feet S. of Litz' Bridge, 100 feet from overhead crossing of R.R. thence following the line of the R.R. at 50 feet from center of track a distance of 512 feet. Thence N.81°W. 613.5 ft to a point 12 ft N. of marked Appletree. Thence West, 1295 ft to line of Jno Haney. Thence following the division line between P. Gallagher and J. Haney S.2°30' W. 1100 ft to road leading from Jacob Haney's to the ridge.

Along said road 322.5 ft to two small W.Oaks. Thence still through P.Gallagher, S.59°E.303.5 ft, S.67°30'E.581 ft to a W.Oak stump at the road to Coal Run.

For Vacation--Beginning at the above named W.Oak stump N.52°W. 239', N.39°W.

210.6', to portion of Creek road to be vacated N.21W.123', N.27°E.161.5'N.

57° E.157.8', N.73°E.225.6', N.83°30'E.250', N.77°30' E.264.7', N.7°30'W.390',
N.56°30'E.862' to point on Sanborn Road near Litz' Bridge, being the beginning
of survey for supply.

Reviewers cannot interfere with damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.
