CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the 2³ day of *June* A. D. 1864 before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Houston* in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ~~road or highway~~ *private* to lead from *the Cabin of*

Alexander Irwin on the land of said J. A. Ostro to the cleared land of Franklin E. Hewitt near Hewitts Landing on the Susquehanna Creek

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Alex. Irwin, Franklin Hewitt, Alvin Bliss -

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a ~~public~~ or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

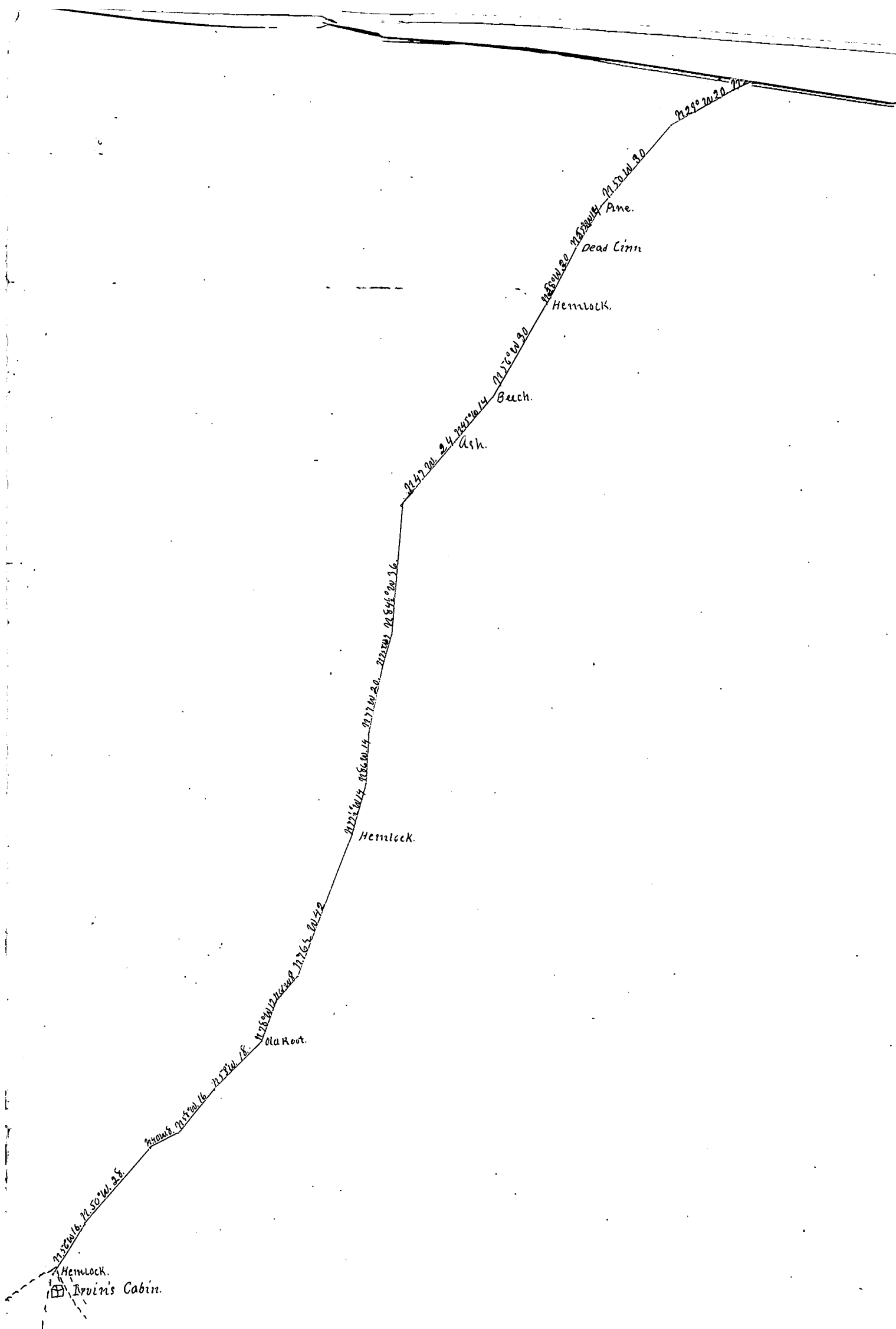

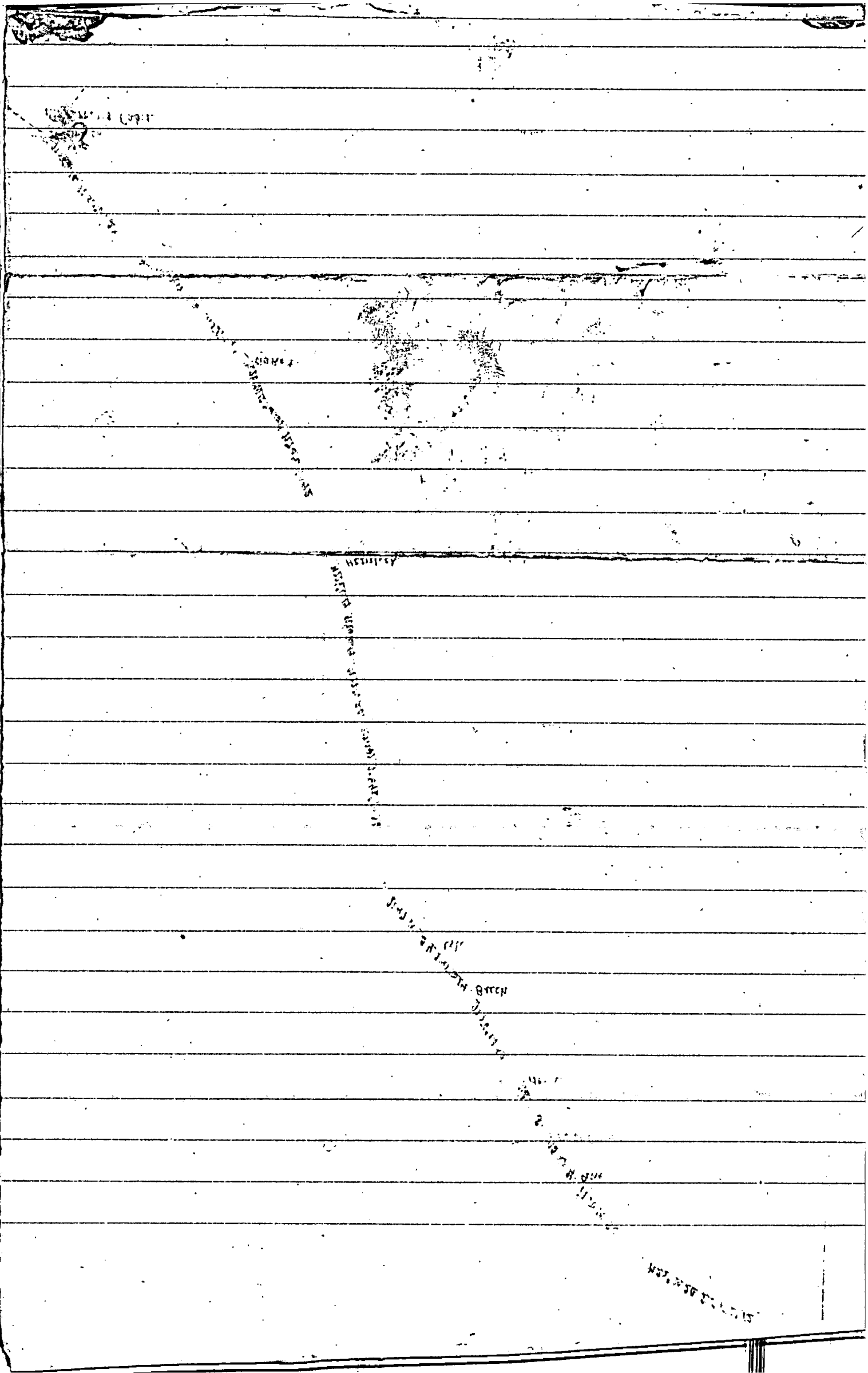

by said Road north 53 deg west 18 perches to Old Post = thence by said Road
north 78 deg west 18 perches = thence north 61 west 8 ps = thence north 76 1/2 deg west
by said Road 42 perches to hemlock = thence 77 1/2 deg to 14 perches = thence north
86 7/8 deg west by said Road 14 perches = thence by said Log Road north 77 deg
