without any fraud or further delay, then this obligation to be void and of none effect, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

And further, ~~do hereby authorize and empower any attorney of any Court of Record of Pennsylvania, or elsewhere, to appear for and confess judgment against for the above sum, with or without declaration, with costs of suit, release of errors, without stay of execution, and with per cent. added for collection fees, and also waive the right of inquisition on any real estate that may be levied upon to collect this Bond, and do hereby voluntarily condemn the same, and authorize the Prothonotary to enter upon the Fi. Fa. said voluntary condemnation, and further agree that said estate may be sold on a Fi. Fa., and hereby waive and release all relief from any and all appraisement, stay or exemption laws of any State now in force or hereafter to be passed. Said collection fee is hereby directed to be added in and to constitute a part of said judgment.~~
