Article of Agreement; made and concluded this      day of  
1908, by and between Clarence Warden and Clark Hepburn of  
Grampian, Clearfield County Pa, of the first part and the  
Commissioners of Clearfield County of the second part.  
Witnesseth that; the party of the first part, for the  
consideration hereafter mentioned, covenants with the parties  
of the second part to perform in a faithful and workmanlike  
manner the following specified work, viz; Scrape and brush off  
all rust dirt and other accumulation, and paint one coat, all  
of the superstructure of two iron bridges across Clearfield Creek  
, one at *Porters* and the other at  
inclusive of the railings, cross rods, joists, and all other  
parts that have been painted at any time and are a part of  
said bridges.

In consideration whereof the party of the second part agrees with  
the party of the first part, to furnish all paint used on said  
contract and deliver the same to the nearest Rail Road Station  
and to pay to the party of the first part the sum of twenty  
five (.25) cents per. lineal foot, after inspection and acceptance  
by the said County Commissioners.
