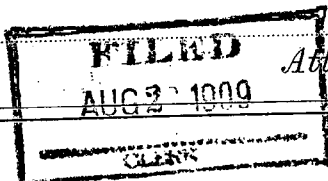

Now, December Sessions, 1909, the foregoing Report of Viewers approved or concurred in by the Grand Jury at this session comes before the Court for approval. We do not concur in the Report with reference to the superstructure of iron or steel, as the Report of the Viewers had nothing to do with that subject. Unless there are engineering objections thereto, we will not authorize the expenditure of County moneys towards the erection of any iron or steel structures within the County. The span of the bridge recommended in this case being only 22 feet, it is not clear to us that the County of Clearfield should be called upon to appropriate any County funds toward such bridge. The rule heretofore existing in the County has been for the appropriation towards bridges only when they were of much greater span than said 22 feet, and we know of no reason now why the County should make an exception of this bridge. If the County is to enter upon the making of 22 foot span bridges throughout the County wherever asked for, by appropriation or otherwise, there would be such a demand upon County funds as would overlap its resources in a very brief time.

In view of the fact that we have already approved the bridge to No. 10 September Sessions, 1909, for DuBois Borough, on the same street on which this bridge is located, it seems to us that the Borough of DuBois should not ask for an appropriation towards this bridge, and for the present at least we withhold our approval.

opinion that a bridge at the point

When Dubois Street Crosses a
Small Stream Known as Little
Juniatta Creek is Necessary to the
traveling public said bridge to
be twenty two feet long between
the abutments and the bottom
of girders to be seven feet above
low water mark. We would recom-
mend that the abutments be built
of concrete and the superstructure
of concrete supported by I beams
As we are of opinion that the
whole cost of the erection of said
bridge would be burdensome
to the taxpayers of the borough of
Dubois we would recommend
that the said borough bear the
cost of the substructure and the
filling of approaches and that
the county bear the cost of the
superstructure.
