Inc. Res. Reconstruction
of Public Roads
(By Clearfield Water Co.)
and Sanitary Journals

To the Honorable Allison O. Smith President judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pa; The undersigned viewers appointed by the within order of court for the purposes herein mentioned respectfully report; That we gave notice of the view to the Supervisors of Lawrence Township and Clearfield Water company which notices are attached hereto: That E. Cowen of supervisors and J.B. Nevling Supt of Water Co. were present at the view; that we met agreeable to notices aforesaid and having been severally sworn or affirmed we viewed the road built by the Water company and the old road and report that at the present time the road built by the water company is in good condition, has a good grade and is of greater width than the old road, but is located along a steep sidehill with cut along most of the way on one side and fill, in some places of considerable height, on the other and has several sharp bends. The fill being of loose dirt will ~~will~~ slide for some time and reduce the width of the road to some extent. The cuts are nearly perpendicular and the dirt will slide down and fill the ditches necessitating its removal from the roadway, and the sharp bends convex toward hill rigs drive close edge of road and most of the road should have guardrail for safe travel. We recommend that the water company keep the dirt cleaned off the roadway as it slides into the road for a period of two years or give the cut a slope of approximately one to one at once: That some of the dirt so moved be placed at sharp curves hereinbefore mentioned to widen road at those points, and that any stones removed from cut be placed along lower side of road to act as a railing; and that 2500 feet of sufficient railing be placed at places directed by supervisor. When the work above recommended is done the new road would be in our opinion a permanent road fully as good as the old road.



TO THE HONORABLE ALLISON O. SMITH, PRESIDENT JUDGE:-

The petition of the Clearfield Water Company, respectfully represents: That it is a corporation of the State of Pennsylvania, incorporated for the purpose of supplying water to the public, and that it has and does supply water to the Borough of Clearfield and vicinity. That it has found it necessary in connection with the construction of an impounding reservoir on Moose Creek for the storing of water, to occupy and flow with water a portion of the public road leading from Clearfield to Penfield in the Township of Lawrence, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

The portion of the public highway required to be occupied, is shown on the draft hereto attached, marked "present public road". Petitioner proposes to re-construct the public road so required to be occupied by it, at its own proper costs and expense, and intends to re-locate the same as shown in draft hereto attached and designated by the words "line of proposed new road", which location is a favorable and suitable one for a public highway. Petitioner further represents that it has come to an agreement with the owner of the land, Elizabeth Buchko, as to the price to be paid to her for the land required for the reconstruction of the road.

The petitioner, therefore, prays that the Court will approve said location proposed for the re-construction of that part of the said highway between Clearfield and Penfield in Lawrence Township, that it finds necessary to occupy as hereinbefore set forth.


