# OPENING ORDER.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on 15th day of May A. D. 1901, before the Judges of said Court, Harry Byers W. P. Harpster, and D. H. Warring

Scarano Quarry adjoins and touches said road and 5790 from intersection aforesaid. Do Report that in pursuance of the said order, they have viewed and ~~laid out~~ vacated, and do return for public use, the following road, to wit: Beginning at a point 4475 feet from intersection of Madera Belsena road with road from Madera to Glen Hope thence N. 9 3/4° 238.1 ft. N. 30° 48.4 ft. N. 13° 45' E. 246.8. 1429 3/4 E. 245' N. 35 1/2° E. 94.6 feet N. 41 1/2° 203 feet, N. 35° E. 150 ft to point 250 feet N. of said S. Scarano Quarry and 5790 feet from intersection of said Madera Belsena road to supply road aforesaid.

AND, we have viewed and laid out and do return for public use the following road to wit; Beginning at a point on the Madera Belsena 3600 feet from its intersection with road from Madera to Glen Hope, thence following said Madera Belsena Public Road 475 ff. to a post at starting point of road vacated as aforesaid thence leaving said road N. 14° 49' W. 117.2 feet to road; thence N. 15 1/2° W. 58.3 feet to post; thence N. 11° 10' E. 55 1/2 feet to post; thence N. 2° 40' E. 184.2 feet to post in centre of road made as aforesaid by S. Scarano; thence in part by said road (the same to be cut down to avoid a level grade) N. 24 1/2° E. 573 to post in centre of road; thence by said road N. 31 1/3° E. 166 feet to post in centre of said Scarano road; thence N. 48 1/2° E. in part by said road and leaving same 351.7 feet to post North of said Scarano

a plot or draft whereof is to the said Report annexed, which report being read the first time at May Sessions, 1911, and the second time on the 37 day of August 1911, the Court approves of and confirms the said road for public use, and orders and directs that it be entered of record, and opened and cleared off the breadth of 33 feet, except where digging or bridging is necessary, and there to be 16 feet, agreeable to the courses and distances aforesaid, of which the Supervisors of the highways of the townships through which the said road runs are to take notice.

Waring who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed ~~vacate~~ <sup>vacate</sup> ~~Supply~~ agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

Smith, President Judge of the Court of Quarter sessions of Clearfield County, Pa., The undersigned receivers appointed by the within order of Court to vacate and supply the road herein mentioned respectfully report that we gave good and lawful notice of the said road, and having been severally sworn or affirmed we received the road proposed to be vacated and supplied, and find that the road formerly in use from Madera to Belsera has been undermined and has fallen away in part at the Scarano Stone Quarry and is unsafe and not wide enough for travel and is not traveled at present, and by reason of the undermining by S. Scarano the part of said road at said quarry has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome and should therefore be vacated to wit: Beginning at a point 4475 feet from intersection of Madera - Belsera road with road from Madera to Glen Hope thence N 9 3/4 W 238.9 ft N 3° E 48.4 ft N 12° 48' E 246.8, 429 1/4 E 246.8, N 35 1/2 E 94.6 feet N 41 1/2 E 24.2 feet N 35 E 150 feet to 6 ft 250 feet North of said S. Scarano Quarry, and 5790 feet from intersection of said Madera - Belsera road with road Madera to Glen Hope at a post at South side of a culvert on said Madera Belsera road. To supply road aforesaid where dangerous at said S. Scarano stone quarry the said S. 
