To The Honorable Allison S. Smith, Presiding  
Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield  
County, Pa. We the undersigned members appointed  
by the written order of court to view the bridge  
therein mentioned, respectfully report: That  
we gave lawful notice of said view by posting  
notices and met notice to Commr of Clearfield  
County attached hereto and met agreeable to said

Notice on Wednesday Jan 22 1813 at the  
bridge spans in the Bois Borough, and viewed the  
location for the proposed bridge: That the Borough of the Bois has passed  
an ordinance, changing the course of 3 streams at proposed bridge, to wit  
Sandy Lick creek, Pint Run & Beaver Run, so that one bridge will an-  
swer for the 3 streams at this point and a considerable change  
in bed of Sandy Lick Creek is proposed to be made by the Borough, the said im-  
provement will be expensive but will greatly improve the condition of the low swampy  
parts of the Bois by giving the creek more fall and carrying the water more rapidly away  
thus avoiding the whole area from being flooded everytime there is a flooding  
of the creek. The expense of improving the channel of the streams and the  
erection of the bridge at the new site is more expense than  
~~in our opinion~~ the Borough of the Bois should bear  
and we therefore recommend that the County of Clearfield pay  
2/3 (two-thirds) the cost of building the said bridge, recommending  
further that it be a concrete structure about 100 feet  
long of two spans or arches about 10 feet in the clear  
above low water and of full width of the street or 40 feet wide.

To the Hon. Allison O. Smith, Judge of the said Court:-
