THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH that whereas certain citizens of Cooper Township, Clearfield County, Pa. have petitioned the Court of Quarter Sessions of said County, praying for the location and opening of a certain public road in Cooper Township.

NOW THEREFORE, if said petition fails or is refused by the Court, then said obligors shall save and keep harmless the County of Clearfield from any and all costs which the said Court may in its discretion impose upon the petitioners. And if the Court does not so impose the costs, then this obligation to be null and void, but otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
