and a map or plot thereof to be made, which shall accompany said report; the report aforesaid to be made to the next term of the Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county of Clearfield.



We the undersigned viewers duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order from among the County Board of viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows.

That notice of the time of the view and the hearing day was duly served according to law, upon the County Commissioners of Clearfield County and the boards of Supervisors of Boggs township and also of Lawrence township and that three notices thereof were posted, near the location of said proposed bridge in each of said townships, that the said view would be held on the 25th day of June 1914 at one o'clock P. M. And that the said viewers appointed, met and viewed the premises or proposed location of said bridge, and that there were present at the view a number of citizens of Clearfield Borough and of Lawrence township and Boggs township in favor of the bridge.

And that the public hearing required by the Act of Assembly and the Rules of Court was held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House at Clearfield Pa on the 27th day of August A D 1914 when the following appearance were noted Ed Cowen & R H Ogden Supervisors of Lawrence township & Cyrus Robison & H U Motter Supervisors of Boggs township & Irvin Rhinehart and Ed Haney

And after the view and hearing aforesaid the undersigned viewers do agree that there is a need for a bridge across Clearfield Creek at the place where the public highway, leading from Osceola to Clearfield(near Krebs station) crosses said creek from Boggs to Lawrence township; but that the expense of the erection of such a bridge would be greater or more then is reasonable that the said townships of Lawrence and Boggs should bear.

We would therefore recommend the erection by the county of a two span, either iron or concrete bridge(whichever can be erected with the least expense to the county), with a twelve foot wide roadway, with iron eyebeam girders, and if an iron bridge to have a creosote block driveway, and if concrete a re-inforced drive way, at an expense not exceeding ten thousand (\$10,000.00) dollars to the county; as per draft attached.
