# Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, Pa., in and for said County, on the 19 day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred fifteen,

Judge of the same Court: Upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township of Covington

in said County, setting forth that


the citizens represent that a road leading from a public road in said Township of Covington at or near what is known as Vignot School house to the abandoned farm of John Birney has become useless and burdensome to the taxpayers of said township, they therefore pray your Hon. Court to appoint viewers to vacate and surpny the same with a public road leading from said Vignot school house to a point on a public road leading from Neator Vignot's to a point on public road at or near said Vignot school house

and therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the road between the points mentioned, whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint from and among the County Board of Viewers A.C. Kramer Esq. Harry Reese and F.J. Billotte

who have been duly appointed by the Court and filed their oaths of office and are duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment, are to view the ground proposed for the said road, and if they view the same, and a majority of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioner as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, in such a manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances and references to the improvements through which the same may pass; (and wherever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said road at an elevation not exceeding five degrees, except at the crossing of ravines and streams, when by moderate filling and bridging the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit,) to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County.

And if the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of locating a public road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road shall pass, releases from any damages that may arise to them on opening the same; but if the owner or owners of such land refuse to release their claim to damages, the said viewers shall assess the same, taking into view the advantages as well as disadvantages arising from said location, and make report of such assessments; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft or plot aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when, and place where, they should meet, to view and lay out said road, and the time and place of hearing

# RETURN OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the County of Clearfield:

We, the undersigned viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows:


That notice of the time of view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Covington and that three notices thereof were posted along the route of the proposed road, that the said view would be held on the 7th day of April, A. D. 1915, and the hearing to be held in the Arbitration Room, in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the day of , 1915, at o'clock A.M. That that the viewers appointed by the said order viewed the ground proposed for the above mentioned road, and that there were present at the view D. F. Guenot, and John Valimout two of the Supervisors of the Township and August Rougeux, John. Voinchet, Alex. Hugene, Nick. Fontoney, Frank. Voinchet, A. L. Pickard, S. E. Reider, and Nester. Mignot.

parties in interest. Then the hearing was held in the Arbitration Room, in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the day of A. D. 1915, when the following appearances were noted:

After the view above mentioned, the undersigned, the majority of the viewers, do agree that there is occasion for a road as desired by the petitioner, and that the same is necessary for a public road; And having had respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for such road we have laid out in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and as far as practicable agreeably to the desire of the petitioner, and do return for public use the following described road, to-wit: Beginning at a point in a public road leading from the residence of Nester Mignot to August Picard on the deviding line between John. Voinchet and August Rougeux; Thence running north five degrees east one thousand (1000) feet to a point in the public road leading from residence of Nester Mignot to a point in the public road leading from Deer Creek to the Mignot School House.

And further report that the public road leading from a point in the public road known as the Deer Creek road at or near the Mignot School House, running south five degrees fifteen minutes west two thousand five hundred (2500) feet to a point near the residence of August Pickard; thence south eighty four (84) degrees, east two thousand five hundred and forty (2540) feet; thence south seventy (70) degrees west one thousand (1000) feet to the barn on the abandoned farm of John Sirgey which after having viewed the same are of the opinion that the same has become useless, inconvenient, and burdensome and ought therefore to be vacated.

There being no contest or objection to said road and no hearing desired the public hearing was dispensed with.

Also, viewers will carefully note the number of days employed and set the amount out at the foot of their return.

Reviewers cannot interfere with the damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.
