TO THE HONORABLE SINGLETON BELL, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT OF
QUARTER SESSIONS OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY:

The undersigned inhabitants of the Township of Boggs,
in the County of Clearfield would respectfully showeth:

That on the seventh day of February, 1916, your
Honorable Court appointed viewers to view a certain public road
leading from Lawrence Township line, at Clearfield Creek, near
the Dimeling Station of the New York Central Railroad, to the
line of Knox Township in said County, for the purpose of consider-
ing the vacation of the same.

That on Monday, the eighth day of May 1916 the report of
the viewers was confirmed Nisi by your Honorable Court. Said
report in part recommended to the Honorable Court that that portion
of said road upon which the view to vacate was asked which lies
between the Lawrence Township line at Dimeling Station to where the
said road intersects the private road of Ross Lambert, be vacated,
the vacation of which road, if confirmed absolutely by your Honor-
able Court, will be injurious to a number of your petitioners
burdensome and detrimental to the inhabitants of the Township,
and your petitioners would, therefore, pray your Honorable Court
to appoint viewers to review this road and make report according
to law.
