CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the 22 day of March A. D. 1864 before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Barthans in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway to lead from C & H Schramm's

Mill to Lissumetown Road

Assess Damages if any in report

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to ^{Review} ~~view~~ and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Peter Lamm Esqr. J. W. Potter & Alex D. Murray

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to ^{be} view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.



We the persons appointed to review the road mentioned and parts adjacent do report, That in pursuance of said order, we did review the same, and have laid out for public use the following road, to wit, beginning on the Sinemahoning road thence North eighty eight west one hundred perches thence South one and half west forty four perches thence South forty nine west twenty perches thence South thirty five west twelve perches thence South twenty and half west forty perches thence South fifteen and half west eight perches thence South thirty one west thirty six perches thence South twenty three west fifty four perches thence South seven west eight perches thence South thirteen and half East fourteen perches thence South eight and half west six perches thence South thirty two west thirty eight perches thence South thirteen and half west twenty two perches thence South five west twenty six perches thence South sixty one and half East thirty eight perches thence South thirty one and half East ten perches thence South ten East twelve perches to Schmars Mill, Witness our hands this sixteenth day of September A.D. 1864
