TO THE HONORABLE SINGLETON BELL, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE
COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY:

The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants
of the Township of Sandy, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania,
would respectfully represent:

That a road has been lately laid out by
order of Court from a point on the public road leading
from the Brook's farm to Michael Resinger at a point imme-
diately opposite the termination of the road leading from

NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH that if the obligors shall save, protect and keep harmless the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from all costs arising out of a certain petition for a review of a certain public road in Sandy Township beginning at Resinger's mill and ending at a point near lands of Hiram Ferrier. In the case of the granting of said road, then this obligation to be null and void otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
