TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE  
PEACE OF THE COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD.

The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants of the  
Township of Sandy and the City of DuBois in said County  
respectfully shewth:

That a road has been lately laid out by order of the Court,  
beginning in what was formerly the Borough of DuBois (now the City  
of DuBois) in said County and State, at a point where North Main  
Street and West DuBois Avenue intersect and to end in the public  
road leading from DuBois aforesaid to Falls Creek Borough at the  
intersection of Public road therewith near the dwelling house of  
Mrs. William Larkey, situate thereon at a point Eighteen Hundred  
Fifty-five (1855) feet West from where the tracks of the Buffalo,  
Rochester and Pittsburgh Railway intersect said Highway in the  
Township of Sandy and said County, and to vacate a public road  
originally laid out and now opened from the terminus of said  
proposed road near the dwelling of Larkey's aforesaid to a point  
in Quarry Avenue, a street from DuBois to Johnson's Mines, which  
road and vacation of road (if confirmed by the Court) will be  
very injurious to your petitioners and to the inhabitants of  
the said Township and City through which the same will pass.

Your petitioners therefore pray your Honor to appoint  
proper persons to review the said road and parts adjacent and the  
road vacated and make report to the Court according to law.
