



Return of Viewers.

To the Honorable the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Clearfield, Pa.

We the undersigned viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court, and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, Pa., beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County and on each member of the Board of Supervisors of Lawrence Township, and that three notices thereof were posted along the public road at and near the location of said bridge, giving notice that the view would be held on wednesday the 22d, day of March A. D. 1916, at four o'clock P. M. ~~AND NO PUBLIC HEARING IS DEMANDED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT JOY AND THE RIVER TOWNSHIP~~

And that the said viewers met at _____ the site or proposed location of said bridge, where the public road leading from The River _____ in Lawrence Township to the Mount Joy _____ in Lawrence Township on wednesday the 22d, day of March A. D. 1916 at four o'clock P. M. and that there were present at the view Ed. Cowen one of the Supervisors of Lawrence Township _____

parties interested in _____ said bridge.

And that the said viewers all having been present at the view and after having made said view do agree that there is a necessity for said bridge, where the new road lately laid ~~been~~ out from the end of west Front Street at the borough line of Clearfield Pa to the public road leading from the River road at the mouth of Moose Creek to Mount Joy crosses said Moose Creek:- They would therefore recommend that a double re-inforced Concrete bridge, Thirty six (36) feet in length, with a driveway sixteen (16) feet in width, six feet above low water mark on solid stone abutments resting on solid bottom be erected at said point where the said public road laid out crosses said stream known as Moose Creek in Lawrence Township as per draft attached:- And that in the opinion of the viewers the cost or expense of the erection of said bridge as recommended, including the abutments will be about Fourteen Hundred (\$1400.00) Dollars, and as said amount owing to the financial condition of the township would in the opinion of the viewers be to heavy and burdensome upon the township alone to bear, they therefore recommend that one half of the cost or expense of the erection of said bridge be paid by the County and the remainder by Lawrence Township.

There being no controversy or contest, nor hearing demanded the public hearing was dispensed with.


where upon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint A. G. Kramer
