To the Honorable Singleton Bell, President Judge of said Court:

The petition of the undersigned, respectfully represents;

That a public road leading from New Millport to Carnwath in Knox Township and known as the New Millport road, was long since laid out and opened; that a part of said road, beginning at or near the Fred Patterson property and extending to a point where said road intersects with the Ansonville road (a distance of less than a mile) has become inconvenient and burdensome on account of excessive grade and washouts and your petitioners believe that said road would be much improved by a change of route, beginning at the Fred Patterson place and connecting with the said Ansonville road at or near the Perry Norris property, which would shorten the distance and avoid grade.

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint qualified persons to View the premises and to inquire into the expediency of making such change, and otherwise proceed as directed by the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided. And they will ever pray, etc.
