that at a point of said Township where the

road leading from Burnside to East Ridge crossed Beaver Run there
is a necessity for a bridge, the old bridge having become delapidated
and needing to be replaced by a new bridge instead of repairs

That said bridge would be of a span of 35 feet or thereabouts with
substantial abutments and would be too expensive for the said township
to build and burdensome upon the tax payers thereof in the present
financial condition of the said Township.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law,

where upon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

A. G. Kramer, E. D. Billotte, and J. S. Michaels

who after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform their duties impartially and to the best of their judgment, are
to view the place proposed for the said bridge, and if they or any two of them, view the same, and any
two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such a bridge, and that the erecting of the said bridge
would require more expense than it would be reasonable the said townships should bear, they are to make report accord-
ingly:

and a map or plot thereof to be made, which shall accompany said report; the report aforesaid to be made to the next
term of the Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county of Clearfield.

Return of Viewers.

To the Honorable the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Clearfield, Pa.

We the undersigned viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court, and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, Pa., beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County and on each member of the Board of Supervisors of Burnside Township, and that Three notices thereof were posted along the public road at and near the location of said bridge, giving notice that the view would be held on Thursday the 29th day of June A. D. 1916, at nine (9) o'clock A. M. ~~REDACTED~~

And that the said viewers met at the location or ~~the~~ site or proposed location of said bridge, where the public road leading from Burnside Borough in Burnside Township to the East-Ridge in Burnside Township on Thursday the 29th day of June A. D. 1916 at nine o'clock A. M. and that there were present at the view Joseph Brothers one of the Supervisors of Burnside Township and A. P. Fry and Clark Beck

parties interested and in favor said bridge.

And that the said viewers all having been present at the view and after having made said view do agree that there is A necessity for said bridge at said point to replace the old wooden structure there now, which is in an unsafe and dilapidated condition, and therefore recommend, that a double reinforced Concrete bridge twenty five (25) feet in length with a driveway sixteen (16) feet in width, seven (7) feet in height above low water mark, with solid concrete or stone abutments laid in cement mortar, resting on solid bottom be erected at said point where the public road leading from the Borough of Burnside to East Ridge crosses Beaver Run in Burnside Township in the County aforesaid as per draft attached as part of our report.

And that in the opinion of the viewers the estimated cost or expense of the erection of said bridge as recommended, including the abutments will be about one thousand (\$1000.00) dollars, and as said amount owing to the financial condition of the said township and the need of other bridges and improvements needed that said amount would be too heavy and burdensome upon the taxpayers of said township alone to bear; and would therefore recommend, that sixty per cent of the cost or expense of the erection of said bridge be paid by the County and the remaining forty per cent be paid by Burnside Township.

The viewers further report, that a change of the course of the bed of the road on the south side of said run is necessary in order to the erection of said bridge at the most suitable place and in the best manner; and have therefore viewed and laid out the road on the South side of said stream as shown on the accompanying draft as follows:

Beginning, at the south side of said run at the location of said bridge thence, South thirty one (31) degrees East one hundred and sixty five (165) feet to the intersection of the present road: And vacate that part of the present road supplied by said change as shown on the draft attached

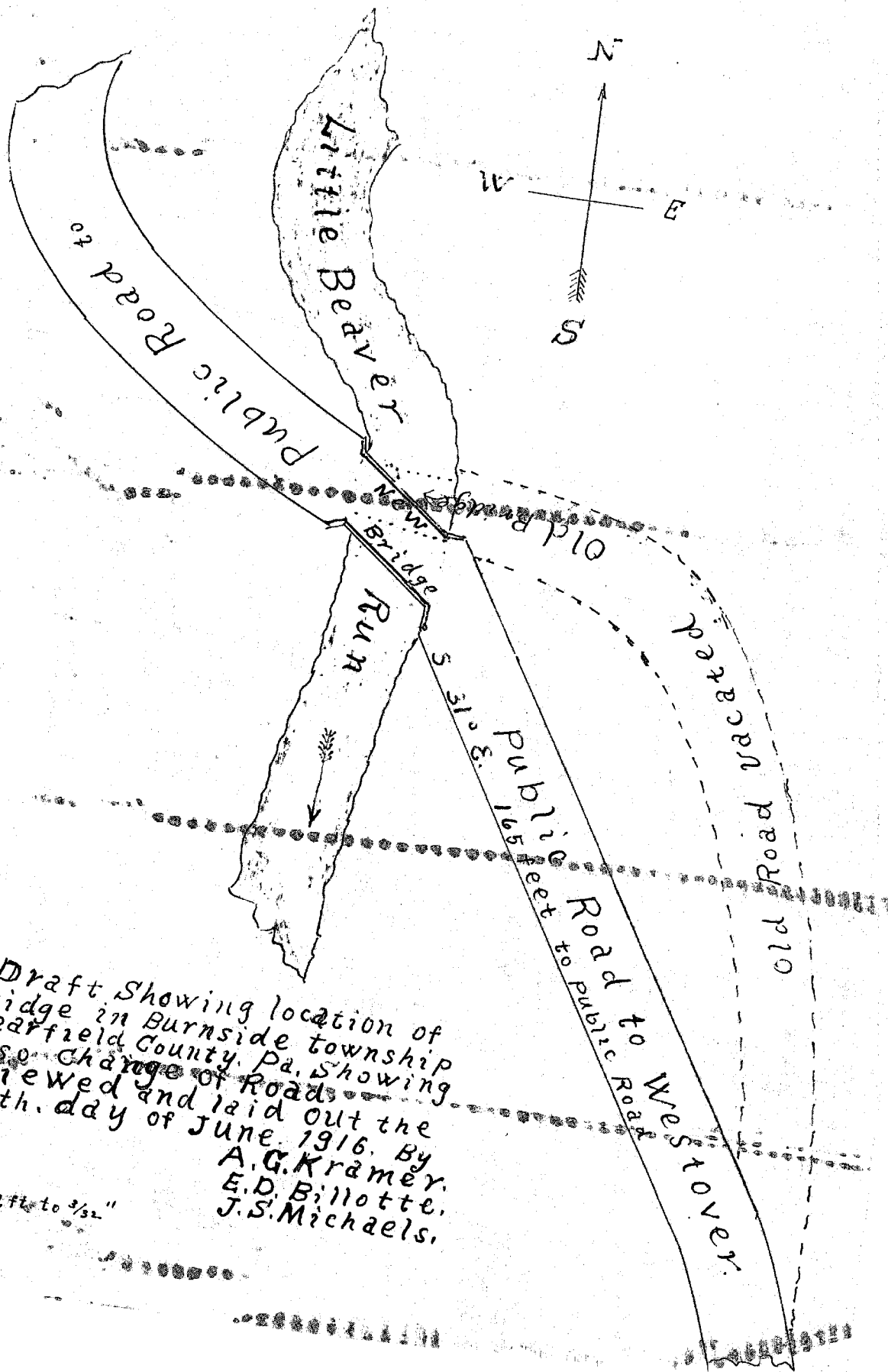

The petition of the supervisors of Burnside Township respectfully represent;
