

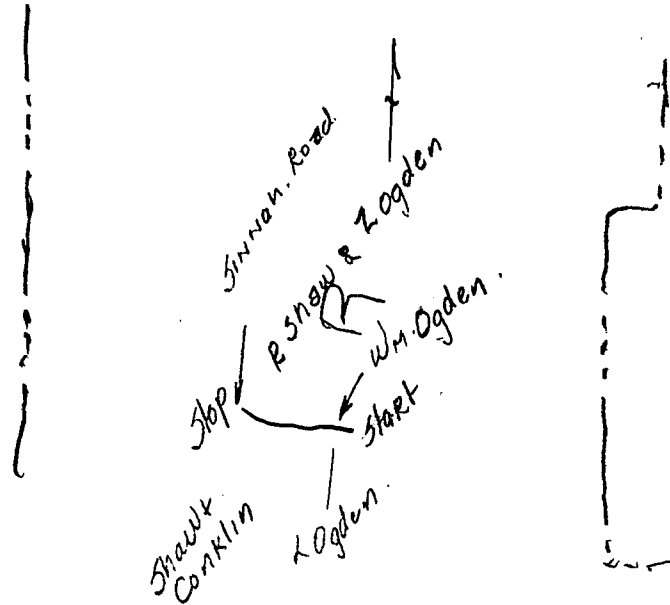

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the *23^d* day of *June* A. D. 1864 before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Lawrence* in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway to lead from *the public*

road at or near John Butters
to the remaining road at
John Shaws

Must report as to damages

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Wm D. Bigler, Samuel Shaffner & Martin Kline

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

We the undersigned persons appointed
by the above order of Court to view and lay out the
road therein mentioned respectfully report:

That we gave notice by printed advertisements
posted in public places in the neighborhood, of the
time & place of said view, ten days previous thereto, in
which day only a portion of the viewers being present
the view was ~~adjourned~~ continued to the 23^d day of
Sept. And on that day being all present, and having
been sworn and affirmed according to law we
went upon the ground proposed for said view & having
examined & viewed the same we do now return for pub-
lic use the following road, to wit: Beginning at
Public Road near John Butters; thence North 80° West 23
perches to fields of W^m Ogden; thence West thro' said fields
50 perches to improvement of J. Ogden; thence same bearing
thro' said improvement 47 perches, thence thro' wood land
N 75° W. 12 perches, N 64° W. 19 perches, N 70° W. 17 perches,
N 53° W. 16 perches, North 8 perches to corner of R. Shaw &
J. Ogden thence West along line of Shaw & Oliver Conklin
98 perches to corner of Shaw & Conklin; thence South 76° W.
40 perches thro' land of said Shaw to Old Simeon making
Road near John Shaw: a plot or draft whereof is hereto
annexed: which said road we are of opinion is necessary
as a public road. Your viewers further report
no damages ^{to accrue} in making said road
