TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGE OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS
OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY.

The petition of the undersigned citizens and inhabitants of
the Township of Sandy, in said county, respectfully represents:

That your petitioners presented to your Honorable Court to
No. September Sessions, 1916, a petition for a public
road to begin on a public road leading from DuBois to Falls
Creek, called "Long Avenue", at a point where a public street
called McLane Avenue intersects said road, which is one-half
mile South from where the Buffalo, Rochester & Pittsburgh
Railroad crosses said road leading to Falls Creek, and to end
in a public road leading from the City of DuBois to Adrian
Furnace, at a point where the line of what was known as the
Owen Kelly land and the Mrs. Lewis land intersect or corner,
four hundred (400) feet West of where said public road intersects
what is known as Quarry Avenue, in the City of DuBois, in said
Township of Sandy, and upon which petition your honorable court
appointed viewers, who met and made a report to September Sessions,
1916, that they could not lay out said road on account of grades.

Your petitioners believe that a road can be laid out between
said points and they labor under grave inconvenience by reason
of not having said road. A street or highway has been
dedicated and is now used by the public and over which the
United States Government at the present time delivers mail to
a number of your petitioners and the said street or highway
not being kept in repair has become in such condition that the
government now threatens to take the mail route from your
petitioners. Your petitioners are tax payers in the Township

of Sandy and believe they are entitled to a road.

They, therefore, pray your honorable court to appoint reviewers to view and lay out said road as prayed for in said original petition and in this petition.

And they will ever pray, etc.
