Road Petition

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the 12 day of January A. D. 1864 before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Johnstown* in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway to lead from *Johnstown* to the *Clearfield* river to another public road at the south west corner of the lot of *Thomas Cook* in *Johnstown*

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint *Wm. B. Riddle, James B. Coleman & John Hanes* who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

End or Road Back

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To the Honorable the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Blairfield County.

We the undersigned persons appointed by the above order of Court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned respectfully report: That having put up printed advertisements of the time and place of view, ten days previous thereto as required by law, we were all present on the day appointed and having first been sworn and affirmed we went upon the ground proposed for said view & having examined it, we do now return for public use the following road: Beginning at South West corner of Wiram Luch; lot thence North One degree East forty seven (47) perches along line of fence of Mullen & Luch thence between the improvements of Luch & Jno. Hanover & South $88\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East $17\frac{1}{2}$ perches to Maple corner thence on line between improvements of Jno. Hanover & J. Baxter Caldwell North One & a half degree East seventy eight (78) perches to public road leading from Jno. Hanover to the river - a draft or plat whereof is hereto annexed; which said road we are of opinion is necessary as a public road. Your witnesses report no damages to accrue from the aforesaid view.
