

A D 1919.-

Whereas the said Amos H Westover has made application for the laying out of a private road through lands of David Lloyd from his coal bank to Public road in Chest Township near the residence of S J Rodtkey .-

Now the condition of this obligation is such that if the said Amos H Westover shall well and truly pay all costs and damages that may be assessed by the viewers appointed to lay out said road then this obligation to be null and void or else to be and remain in full force and virtue .-
