At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield,
held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the 14 day of
January A. D. 1864 before the Judges of the said Court upon
the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Ridge
in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience
for the want of a road or highway to lead from Saville

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to
law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint
W. J. Bigler, Garrison Bailey and Garrison Hartshorn

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

On the undersigned persons appointed by the above order to view and lay out the road therein mentioned would respectfully report: That having posted printed advertisements of time and place of the view, ten days beforehand as required by law we were present on the day appointed and having first been sworn and affirmed we went on the ground proposed for said road and having examined it we do now return for public use the following road to wit. Beginning at corner of fence of Jacob Passmore near the saw mill of Jonathan Hartshorn three North 21° West 48 perches three North 23° West 35 perches three North 18° West 28 perches three North 5° East 32 perches three North 2° West 28 perches three thousand improvement of Widow Smeal North 2° East 34 perches thro thin wood land North 2° West 32 perches three North 40° West 12 perches three North 29° West 94 perches to lane of David Ulmer, a draft or plot whereof is hereto annexed, which said road we are of opinion necessary for a public road. Your view, further report no damages to accrue from such view.
