The Petition of the undersigned, the inhabitants of the Borough
of Irvona, and of the Township of Beccaria, in said County,
respectfully shows:-

That a road has long since been laid out, partly in
Beccaria Township, and partly in Irvona Borough, from a point
near Fairview School house on the public road leading from Glen
Hope to Irvona at a point near DeWitts Run at the intersection
of said road with the road running from Irvona to Ansonville,
a distance of eight thousand feet, more or less; that on account
of its grades and hills your petitioners believe that said road
is now useless, inconvenient and burdensome; that said road is
known as the Godfry Hill Road.

Your petitioners pray the Court that the said road
may be vacated, agreeably to the Act of the General Assembly in
such case made and provided; and that its place be supplied by
a road substantially between the same points, avoiding the present
hill; that petitioners believe this result can be accomplished
at about a three per cent grade for the new road.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.
